Bids opened on Friday, May 2, 2008. Mandt Trucking & Excavating, Inc. low bid of \$194,037.50. Upon further review, bid item was left out. Mandt bid is considered an irregular bid. Sun Prairie Sand & Gravel bid was opened at the BPW Meeting of May 7th pending SBE approval. Sun Prairie Sand & Gravel submitted their bid on time but then said they believed the bid bond was not included in Envelope No. 1, thus making this bid incomplete. Sun Prairie Sand & Gravel stated on 5/2 that they now believe their bid bond was included in Envelope No. 1 when it was submitted. When the envelope was opened at the Board meeting on 5/7/08, bid bond was included in the enevelope and the bid itself had no bid pricing listed; thus making Sun Prairie Sand & Gravel an irregular bid. Raymond P. Cattell, Inc. is now considered the low bidder with a contract bid amount of \$204,336.50.
