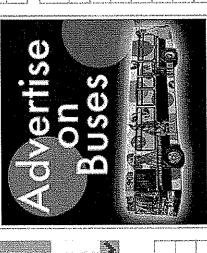

ACCESSIBLE SERVICES

Metro Transit is committed to providing a public transportation system that can be used by all of our customers. We encourage individuals to take advantage of the independence and flexibility that is provided by our <u>fixed route</u> and <u>paratransit service</u>.

Automatic Bus Stop Announcements

All buses are equipped with Annunciator Technology that <u>automatically announces</u> the locations of major stops and intersections to help passengers orient themselves and prepare to get off the bus at the correct stop.

If you need further assistance finding your destination, ask your driver when boarding.

· Complete Details

Kneeling Buses

All fixed-route buses kneel to help accommodate passengers with limited mobility. This permits the front entry door to be lowered to a more convenient level for boarding.

Wheelchair Securement Areas

Seats in the front of fixed route buses are designed and designated to provide easy access for people with disabilities.

These seats fold up to create the securement area for passengers in wheelchairs. All Metro buses have two reserved areas with securement systems to provide a safe ride.

Paratransit Service

The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990 requires public transit agencies to provide <u>paratransit service</u> to persons with disabilities who cannot access the public transit system due to their disability.

Paratransit service complements the same area and hours of Metro's fixed-route system.

Riders must fill out an <u>application</u> and be an <u>eligible registered paratransit rider</u> to use this service. Metro provides paratransit service for passengers unable to use fixed-route buses in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Paratransit Information in Audio Format

Paratransit information is now available in <u>audio format</u>. You can listen to all paratransit trip requirements, eligibility standards and riding tips.

Paratransit No-Show Appeal

Riders will be charged \$5 for each no-show. Excessive no-shows may also result in a suspension of service.

In all cases where service may be suspended, the passenger will be given an opportunity to appeal. Appeals must be made in writing or via filling out an online form.

Personal Care Assistants

PCA's ride free on both paratransit and fixed-route service when accompanying an individual with a disability.

As according to the American with Disabilities Act (ADA), Metro Transit permits service animals to accompany individuals with disabilities on Metro Transit buses/facilities.

Service animals are animals that are individually trained to perform tasks for people with disabilities. (Pets can be taken on Metro buses as long as they are secured in a pet carrier small enough to fit on your lap).
