The Spark by Hilton Madison Central is a multi-story, limited-service hotel featuring 140 guest rooms and a range of public and private spaces where alcoholic beverages may be sold, stored, or consumed. The hotel is designed to support both lodging and small-scale events or social gatherings in designated areas.

Alcoholic beverages will be **sold** and **stored** only in the following areas:

- Market Area: Located on the first floor near the front desk, the hotel's retail market serves as the primary point of sale for beer and wine. Products will be displayed in a secure, refrigerated case, with additional inventory stored in a locked back-of-house storage area accessible only to authorized hotel personnel.

Alcoholic beverages may be **consumed** by registered guests or event attendees in the following approved areas:

- **Guest Rooms**: Guests may purchase alcohol from the market and consume it within their individual guest rooms located throughout the building.
- **Lobby Area**: Guests may consume beverages in the lobby's casual seating areas. Alcohol is not served here but may be brought from the market.
- **Outdoor Patio**: The hotel features a small outdoor seating area adjacent to the lobby. Guests may consume alcoholic beverages in this area, in accordance with hotel policy and local regulations.
- Indoor Pool Area: Located on the ground level, the indoor pool is available for guest use. While no alcohol is served here, guests may bring beverages purchased from the market into the space, provided safety and cleanliness guidelines are followed.
- **Banquet/Meeting Rooms**: The hotel includes one or more flexible-use banquet and meeting rooms intended for private and corporate events. Alcoholic beverages may be served and consumed in these rooms during approved functions, subject to the terms of the license and responsible service practices.

All alcoholic beverages will be securely stored in designated storage areas when not on display. Alcohol service and consumption in public places will be monitored by trained staff to ensure compliance with state and local laws, as well as brand and property standards.
