STATEMENTS OF POLICIES AND GUIDELINES FOR NAMING PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS WITHIN THE MADISON PARK SYSTEM

AUTHORIZATION

The Madison Board of Park Commissioners is responsible for designating a name for all Park and Recreation areas within the Madison Park System.

PROCEDURE

- A "Naming Committee" may be appointed by the Park Commission. It shall be the
 responsibility of the Naming Committee to receive from the Park Commission requests
 for the naming of specific Park, and Recreation areas within the Madison Park System.
 The Naming Committee may also initiate the selection of a name for a Park or
 Recreation area.
- 2. Requests or proposals for adopting a specified name for a particular Park or Recreation area shall be submitted to the Park Commission in written form along with thorough documentation giving the reasons for the selection of the proposed name. The proposal is then to be referred to the Naming Committee for evaluation, research, consideration and recommendation to the Park Commission. The Park Commission will act upon the recommendation of the Naming Committee.

GUIDELINES FOR THE SELECTION OF NAMES

Park and Recreation areas may be named:

- For location, such as the name of an adjacent street or the related plat or subdivision.
- For a geologic, geographic, historical, botanical, horticultural or scientific feature inherent to the area.
- To honor a person or persons who make(s) a substantial contribution to the advancement, the improvement or the enlargement of the Madison Park System in the form of donated property or donated money or both for Public Park purposes only.
- To show gratitude to a person who, over a long period of time, has devoted outstanding amounts of time, talent and effort to the advancement of the Madison Park Program and/or the Madison Community.

PARK FEATURES

Important and substantial park features within a named area may be given a name other than the name of the principal area, using the same guidelines as used for naming areas.

PLAQUES, MARKERS, ETC.

All named areas and important Park features shall be identified by the installation of appropriate plaques, signs or markers. A formal ceremony recognizing named areas and important park features shall be at the direction of the Naming Committee, subject to approval of the Park Commission.
