To: Property Owners along American Parkway

Re: Proposed Sidewalk Installation & Public Hearing

The City of Madison is proposing to install sidewalk in front of 5917, 5929, and 6001 American Parkway in 2019 to connect to existing sidewalk along American Parkway. Enclosed is a notification for the Public Hearing before the Board of Public Works. The date, time, and location of the public hearing can be found on the notification.

Also enclosed is a Schedule of Assessments, which shows the estimated costs for your property. After the work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 3% interest charged on the unpaid balance.

Note that the standard assessment policy for this type of project indicates that the costs of new sidewalk are to be assessed entirely to the adjacent property owners. This project is eligible for a Safe Routes Grant. Individual property owners benefit from the grant by receiving a credit equal to 50% of the total sidewalk assessment. The enclosed estimated assessments for each property include the entire costs for the sidewalk installation, and the grant would be applied to the amount due for the sidewalk installation when the final assessments are prepared following the project. The application of the Safe Routes Grant to this project will require a separate approval by the Common Council.

That on <u>WEDNESDAY</u>, <u>NOVEMBER 7</u>, <u>2018 AT 5:30 P.M.</u>, the Board of Public Works will hold a public hearing in <u>ROOM 108 (PARKS CONFERENCE ROOM) OF THE CITY COUNTY BUILDING</u> and will consider any objections that may be filed in writing or in person and hear all persons desiring to be heard, and;

That special assessments may be paid over an eight (8) year period, with the owner paying 1/8 of the principal each year plus three (3%) percent interest on the unpaid balance, as determined by the Board of Public Works.

That if the total assessment is paid in full before October 31st in the year that the billing is made, irrespective of project completion, then no interest shall be charged.
