The City of Madison is proposing to construct Elderberry Road, from 130' east of Samuel Drive to 600' west of Augusta Drive in 2014. This project involves special assessments to owners of property along the project. You are being sent this letter to notify you of the public hearing before the Board of Public Works at the above referenced date, time & location. City Engineering will be making a short presentation at the meeting, followed by the public hearing. Scope of Work
