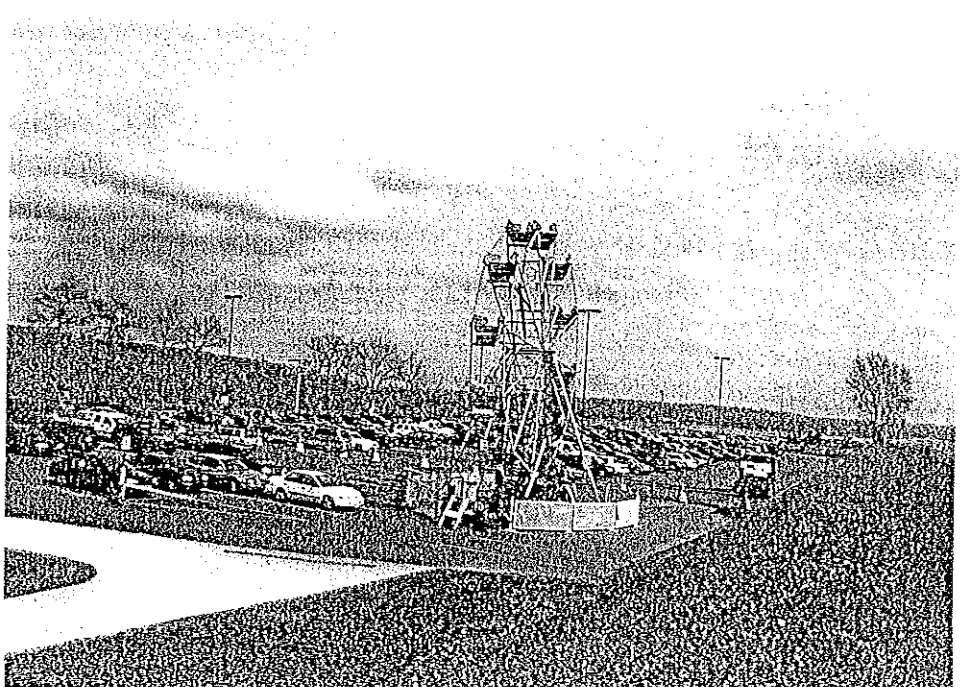
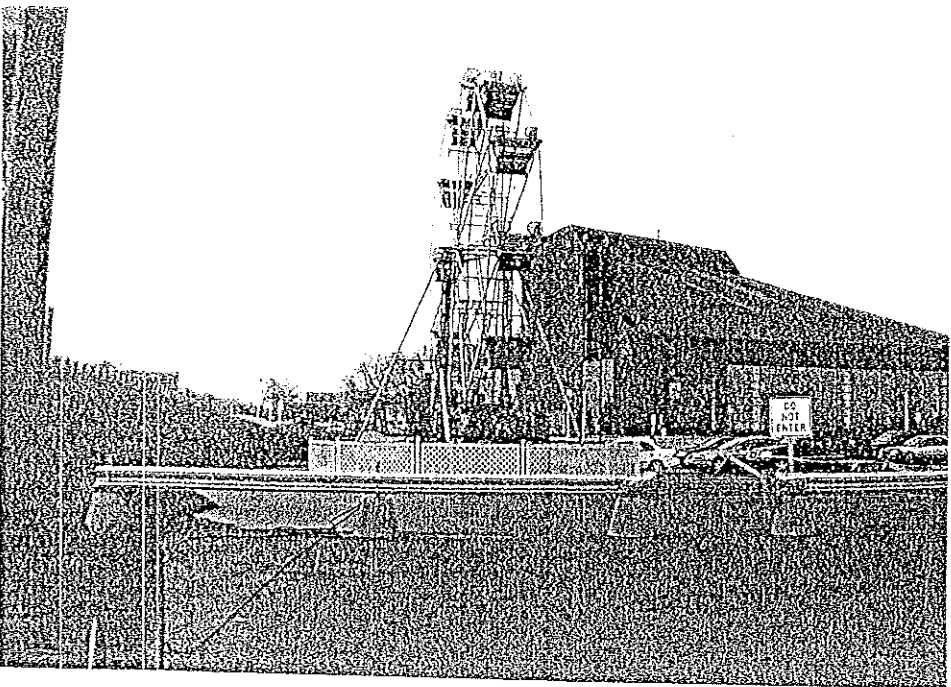
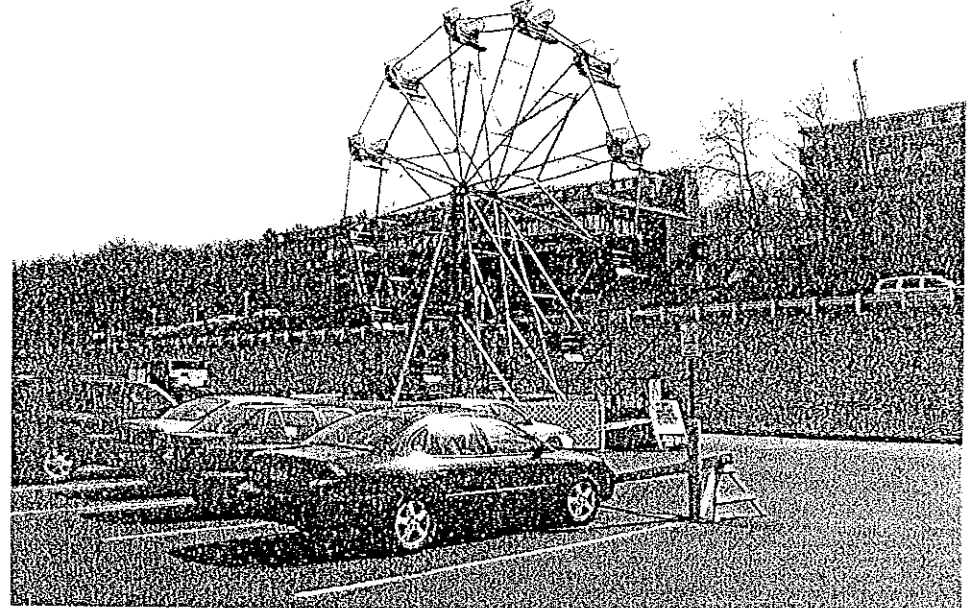
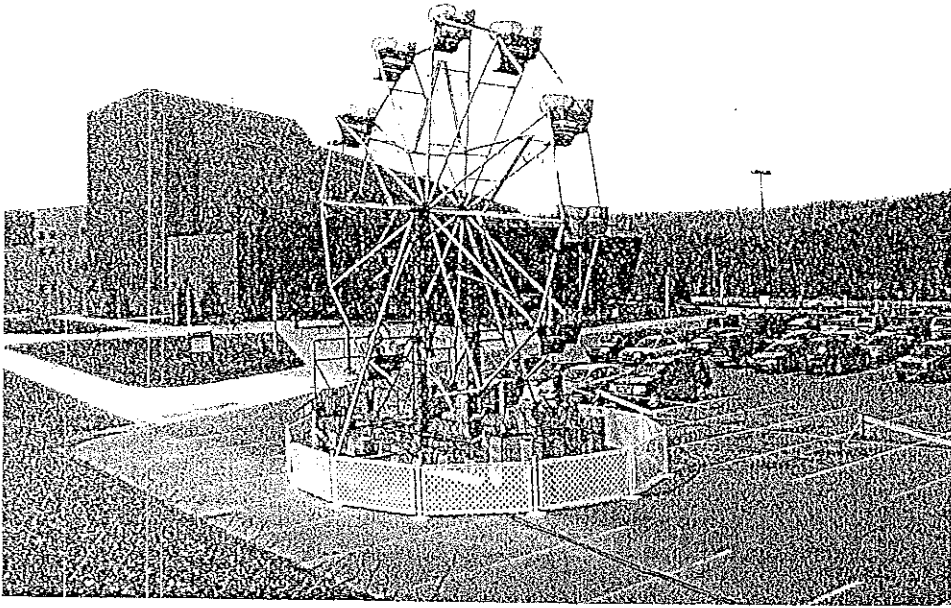


Approximate Location
