The Standard City assessment policy will be followed. There will be a 50/50 split with the property owners on Concrete curb and gutter, sidewalks and driveway aprons and private drive entereances. The streets will open during construction. Two lanes of thru traffic will be maintained during peek travel times. Driveway access to properties will be maintained at all times except when concrete work is being done. At no time will access be closed to any business during the driveway, private entrance replacement. If there is two entrances one may be closed while the other is under contraction.
