Jack Chandler appeared before the Tenney-Lapham Neighborhood Association (TLNA) council April 13 asking that the conditions in our first letter be amended to match those of Parched Eagle to avoid confusion. The TLNA council voted unanimously to support that change. Below is the text from our March letter, changed as agreed.

Jack Chandler appeared before the Tenney-Lapham Neighborhood Association (TLNA) council (March 9, 2017) to request support for an Class A alcohol license. They have an art and music venue at 1444 E. East Washington Street. Maria's will occupy two rooms on the main floor of the building. They hold art events, including visual, spoken word, and music, serving beers for the events. He says that he would like to offer wine and cocktails as well. Events end at 11:00 PM.

The TLNA Council voted unanimously to support the Jack Chandler's request for a Class A alcohol license at Maria's given capacity and hours they described. That is, with the condition that they close at 10:00 on weeknights, 12:00 on weekends, and no outdoor amplified sound or music. Jack Chandler's business has been addition to the neighborhood and the increased activity adds to the attractiveness of our area as a destination for the neighbors and patrons further afield.
