**VARIANCE REQUEST IN URBAN DESIGN DISTRICT #1** 

Dear Urban Design Commissioners;

We are requesting the final approval of a variance to allow a wall sign in Urban Design District #1 to exceed the 10' height limitation on or immediately adjacent to John Nolen Drive.

#### Existing

In February of 1992, we installed a 24" logo and 16" letters to read: FAMILY SERVICE (Permit #N1829 was issued on January 27, 1992).

#### **Current Conditions**

- 1. The property is located in Urban Design District #1.
- 2. Because Olin Avenue is immediately adjacent to John Nolen Drive, we have been asked to apply the same guidelines.
- The signage guidelines are as follows:
  - a. The height of a ground or wall sign shall not exceed ten (10) feet along John Nolen Drive or 18 feet elsewhere in the District unless a higher sign is specifically approved by the Urban Design Commission based on the following criteria:
    - i. An exception from the height limitation is necessary for a sign located on the site of an establishment to be identifiable and legible from the nearest roadway at prevailing speeds; and
    - ii. An exception from the height limitation will result in a sign more in scale with the building and site and will result in a superior overall design.
  - b. The effective area of a ground or wall sign shall not exceed 40 square feet along John Nolen Drive or 72 square feet elsewhere in the District unless a larger sign is specifically approved by the Urban Design Commission based upon the following criteria: ...

### Request for Final Approval of a Variance in Urban Design District #1

- 1. The architecture of the building allows for only one signable area.
- 2. The signable area is located at the top of the building.
- The height of the sign is at 23'-9".
- 4. The total area of the sign, with the addition of the word, "Madison", is 30.975 square feet.


