Hi Jim,

Our bar and restaurant Ba Lao, located on 811 Williamson St., was granted a liquor license this past July, and it stated that we have six months to get our inspections done to complete the process of obtaining our license. After further reviewing the premise at 811 Williamson, it was determined that the plumbing was not up to code, as well as a few other items, such as exposed ceilings in the kitchen and wall runners that were not washable. In order to remedy this, we hired a contractor and an architect and filed for building permits. However, the building permits took longer than expected to pass through (around two months), and our contractors are just now able to start construction tomorrow. There is a good chance that they will not be able to fully finish getting the building up to code before the December six-month deadline, and so we were wondering if we would be able to get an extension for our license grant in order to complete our construction and get the space 100% up to code to pass our inspections.
