CHANGE ORDERS TO PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTS

39. Change Order No. 1 to Contract No. 6061, Park Paving, to Tri-County Paving in the amount of \$3,400.00.

The Parks Division is requesting permission to install an asphalt patch at Warner Park through a change order to the Park Paving - 2008 contract. The last few winters have been particularly hard on the Warner Park parking lot. Last year, a large portion of the entrance road fall apart which was repaired via change order. This year a smaller portion of the entrance road, adjacent to last years patch, fell apart. Originally the construction crew was sent out this spring to undercut the area to create a better base in preparation for a patch. This was done prior to the opening of the Mallards season. Now the Parks Division would like to get it paved before Rhythm and Booms on June 28th, with this change order. Unfortunately, this will continue to happen knowing that the parking lot was built on a swamp and not to modern day engineering standards. (In fact, the construction crew, in preparing the base for this asphalt patch was amazed to find out that there was only a few inches of gravel base in the area that is to be patched before they hit a large vein of peat. They were surprised it lasted this long). Parks is presently working with Engineering to come up with a three phase plan to re-build the parking lot starting in spring of 2010. Phase 1 - the entrance road and the part of the parking lot closest to the baseball diamond - would be completed in conjunction with the opening of the new stadium.
