Hello,

I'm writing to share my serious concerns about the proposed Lakeside Street garage entrance for the new building at 999 S Park. This will create an incredibly dangerous situation for pedestrians, especially for the dozens of school children who cross Lakeside on the East side of Park street and cross Park Street on the South side of Lakeside every morning and afternoon. It is abundantly clear that Park street is already dangerous-my son was hit on his bike crossing Park at the crosswalk, his friend Sasha was killed crossing Park to go to school and every morning I cross Park at Lakeside and less than 10% of cars or buses stop at the crosswalk.

Placing the garage entrance on Lakeside will exacerbate this situation. I would like to understand why the City would make a decision that would put residents, especially children, at greater risk.
