ACTION SUMMARY

Annual review of Metro Transit's Agency Safety Plan (ASP)

BACKGROUND

Our federally mandated Agency Safety Plan was certified on June 24th 2020 in compliance with 49 CFR Part 673. This plan is reviewed, updated and certified annually.

DESCRIPTION

In February 2025, the Metro Safety Planning Team began an annual review of their Public Transit Agency's Safety Plan (PTASP). We were able to exceed each of our safety performance targets except for the category of Safety Events. Due to the changes to the National Safety Plan in 2024, this category (Safety Events) has now changed and been broken down into several subcategories that include vehicle collisions, object collisions, pedestrian collisions and passenger injuries.

Our focus for 2025 is to reduce the number of collisions and injuries we are seeing in service by reviewing each collision with the operator involved. With the operator, we are reviewing the onboard video and, if necessary, retraining each operator in areas related to the collision.

No other major updates have been made to our plan this year other than staff and organizational chart.

EQUITY GOAL IMPACTS

Through our Agency's safety plan we will use customer feedback and the prioritization of risk assessments to identify strategies to reflect equity concerns and priorities.

FISCAL & PROCUREMENT DETAILS

Based on our key safety performance indicators measured in vehicle revenue miles (VRM), resources may need to be allocated to certain areas of Metro's operation to meet our safety goals.
