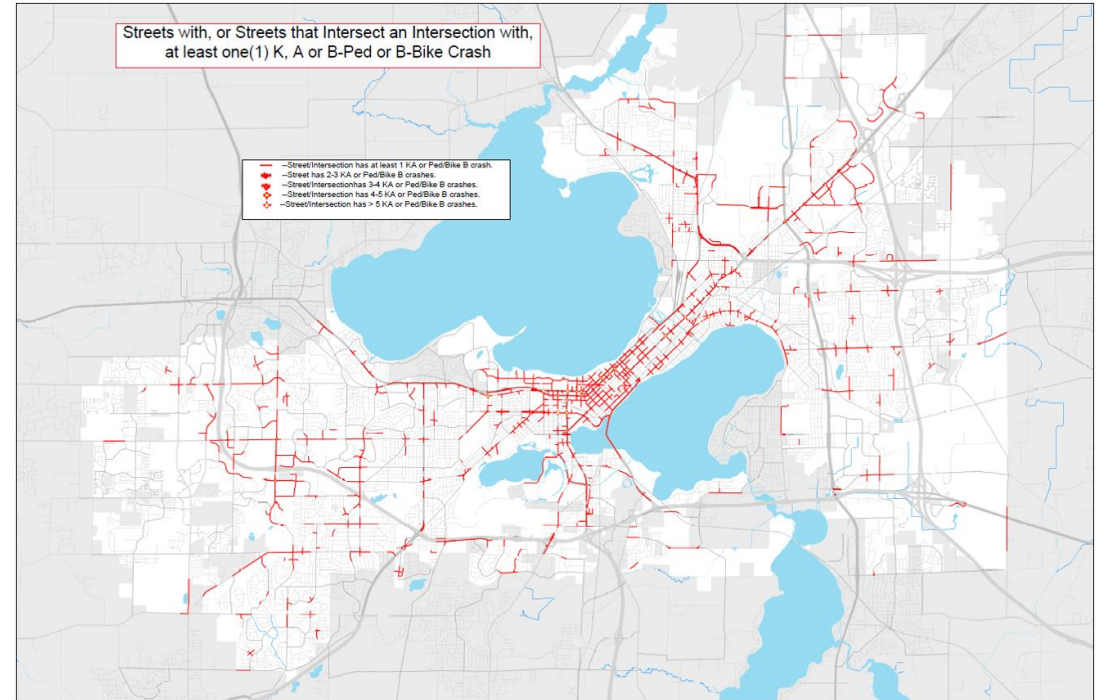
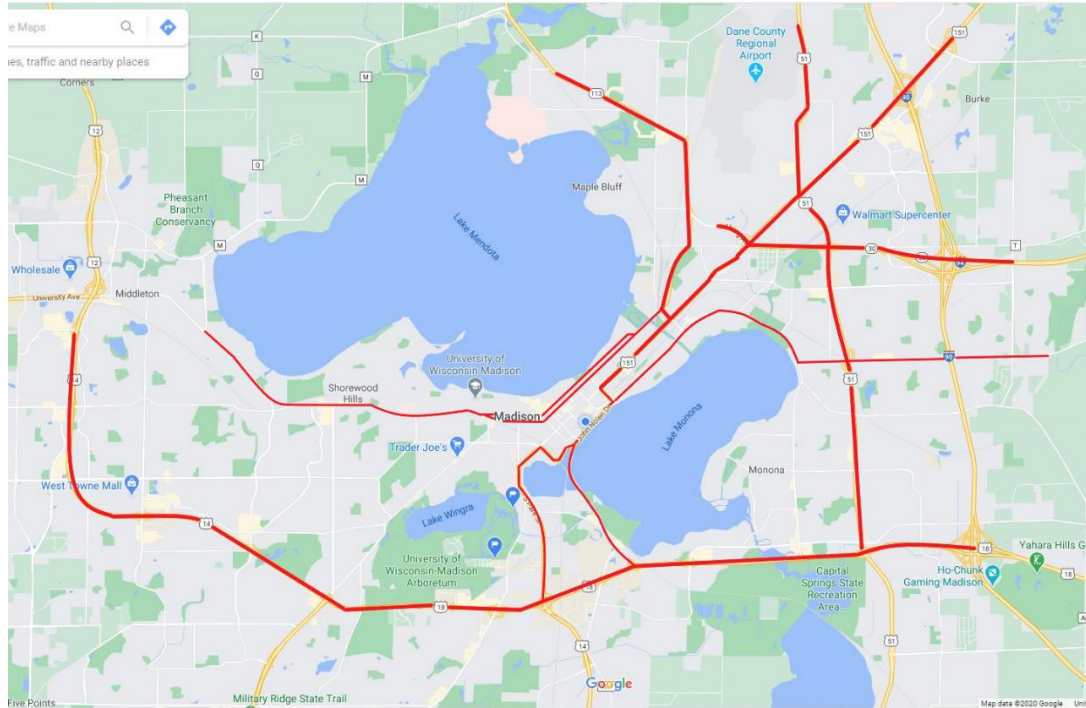

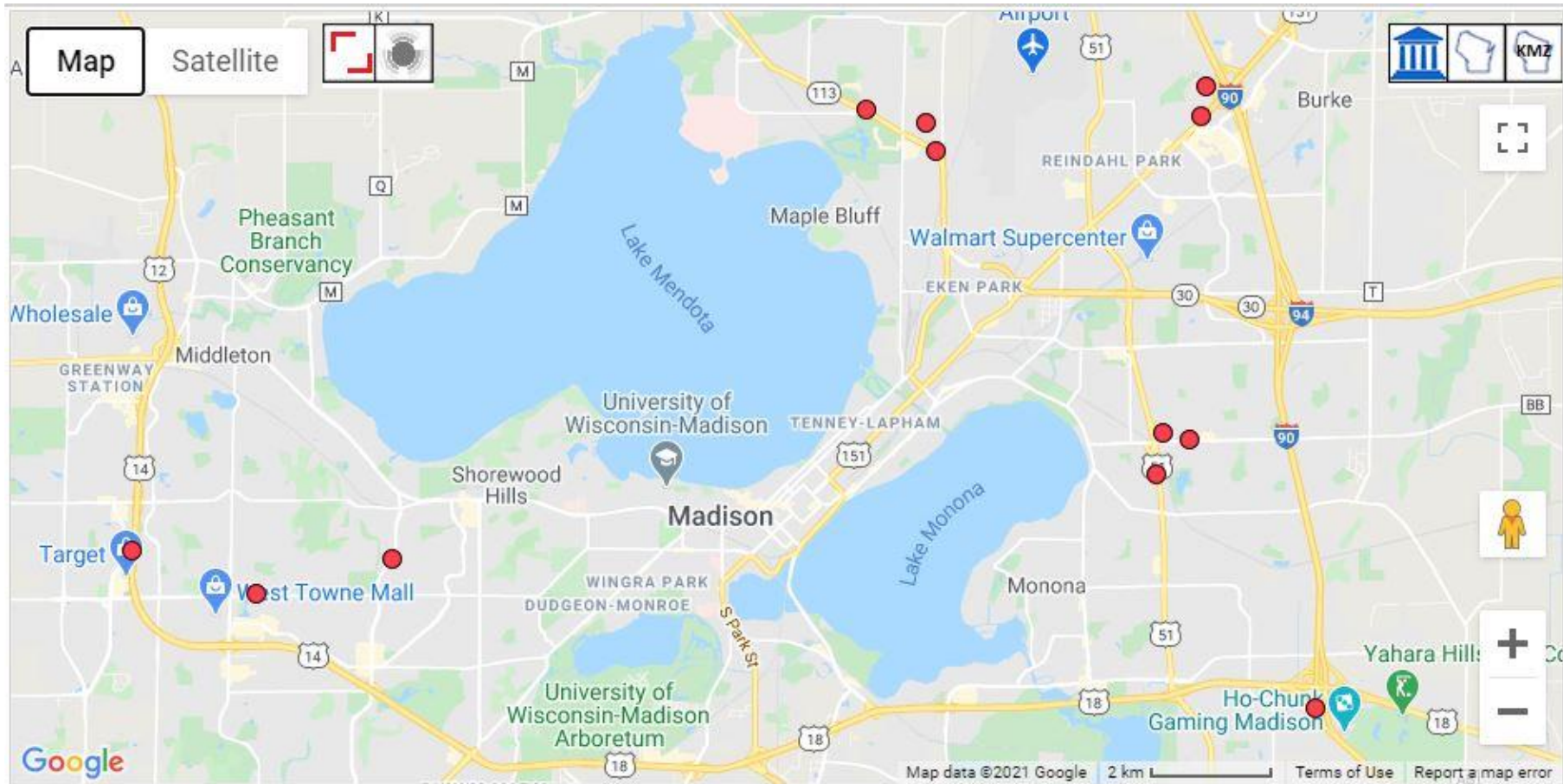


Traffic Grant Corridors / Temp HIN (DRAFT)





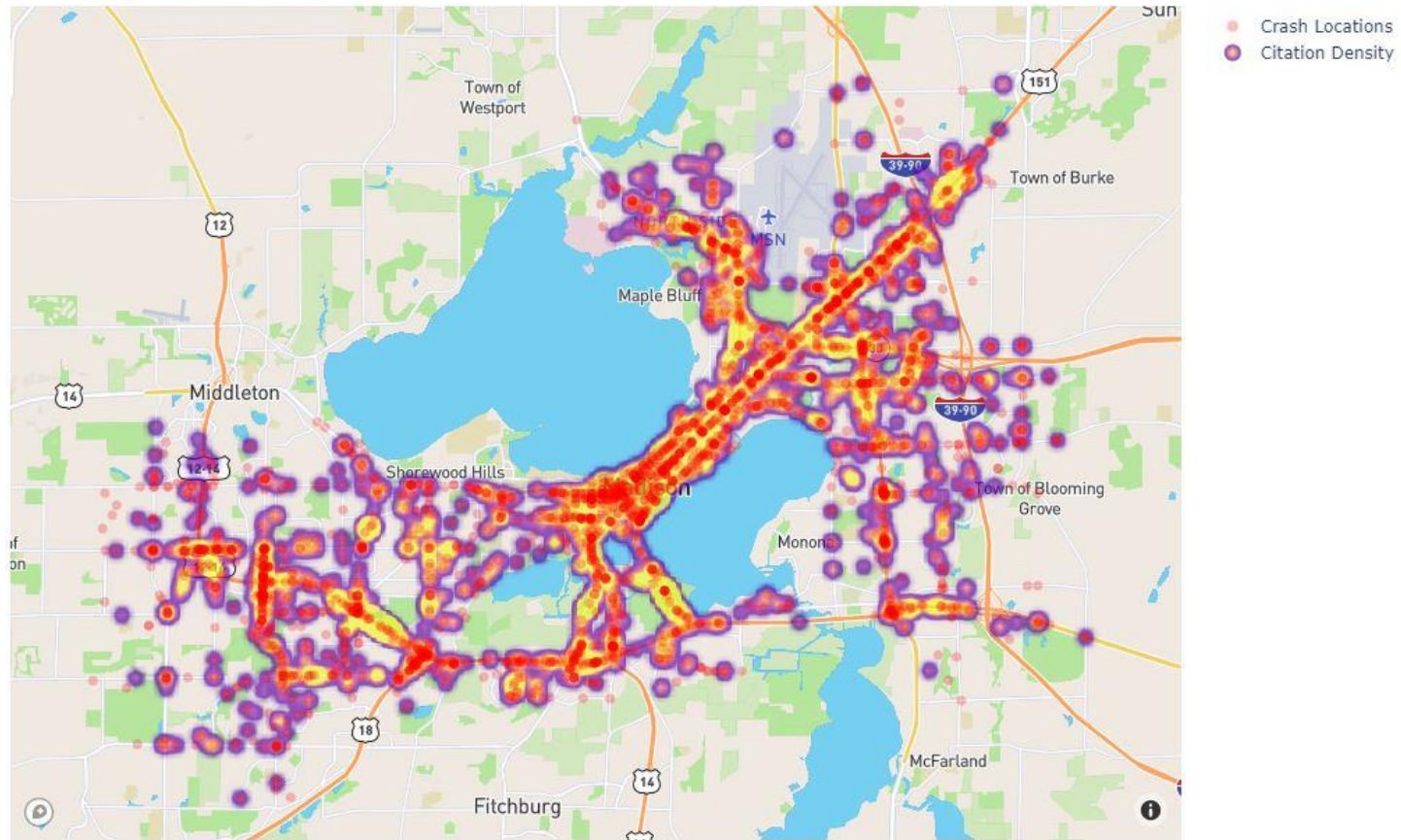
2020 Fatal Crash Locations





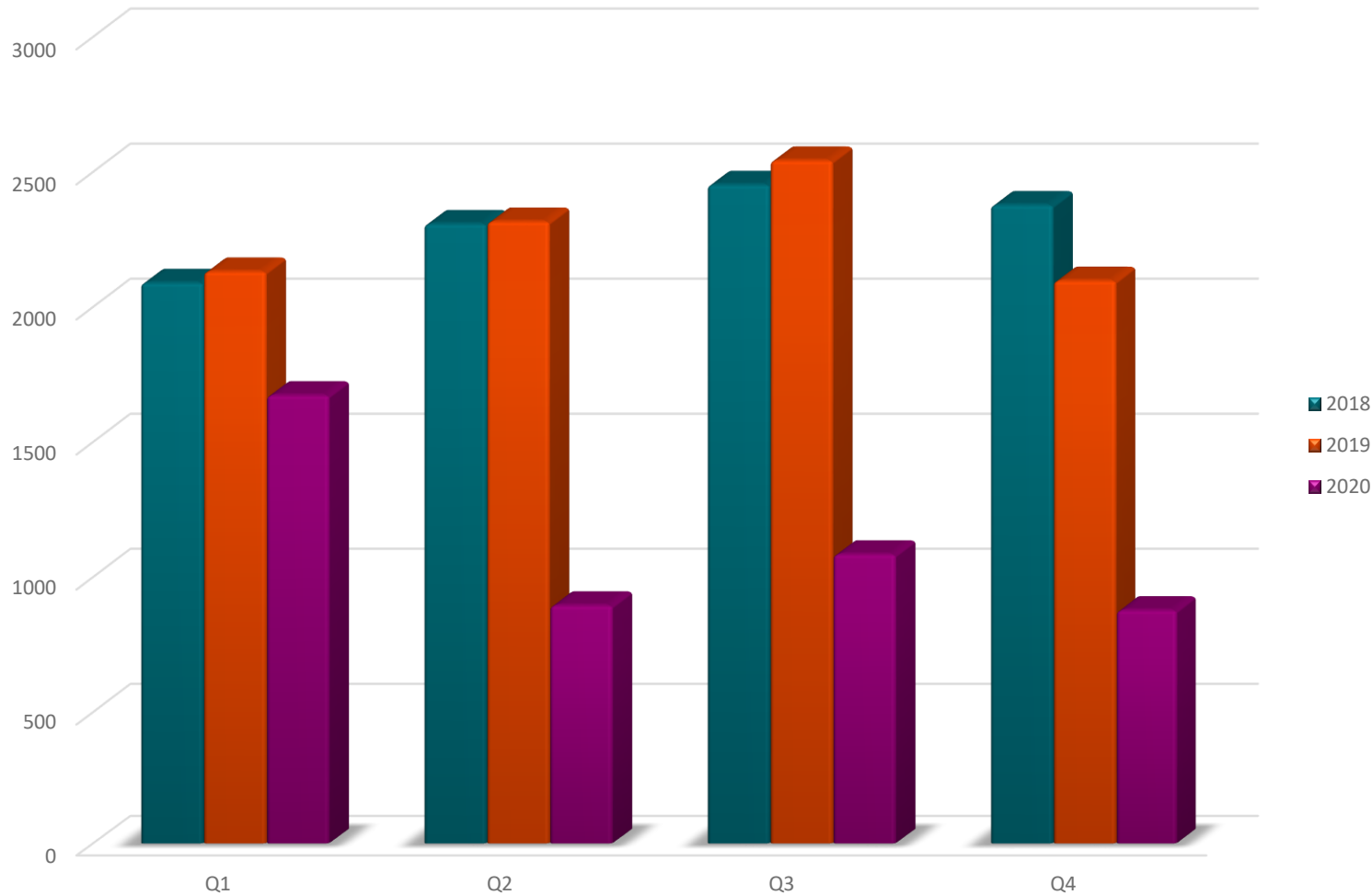

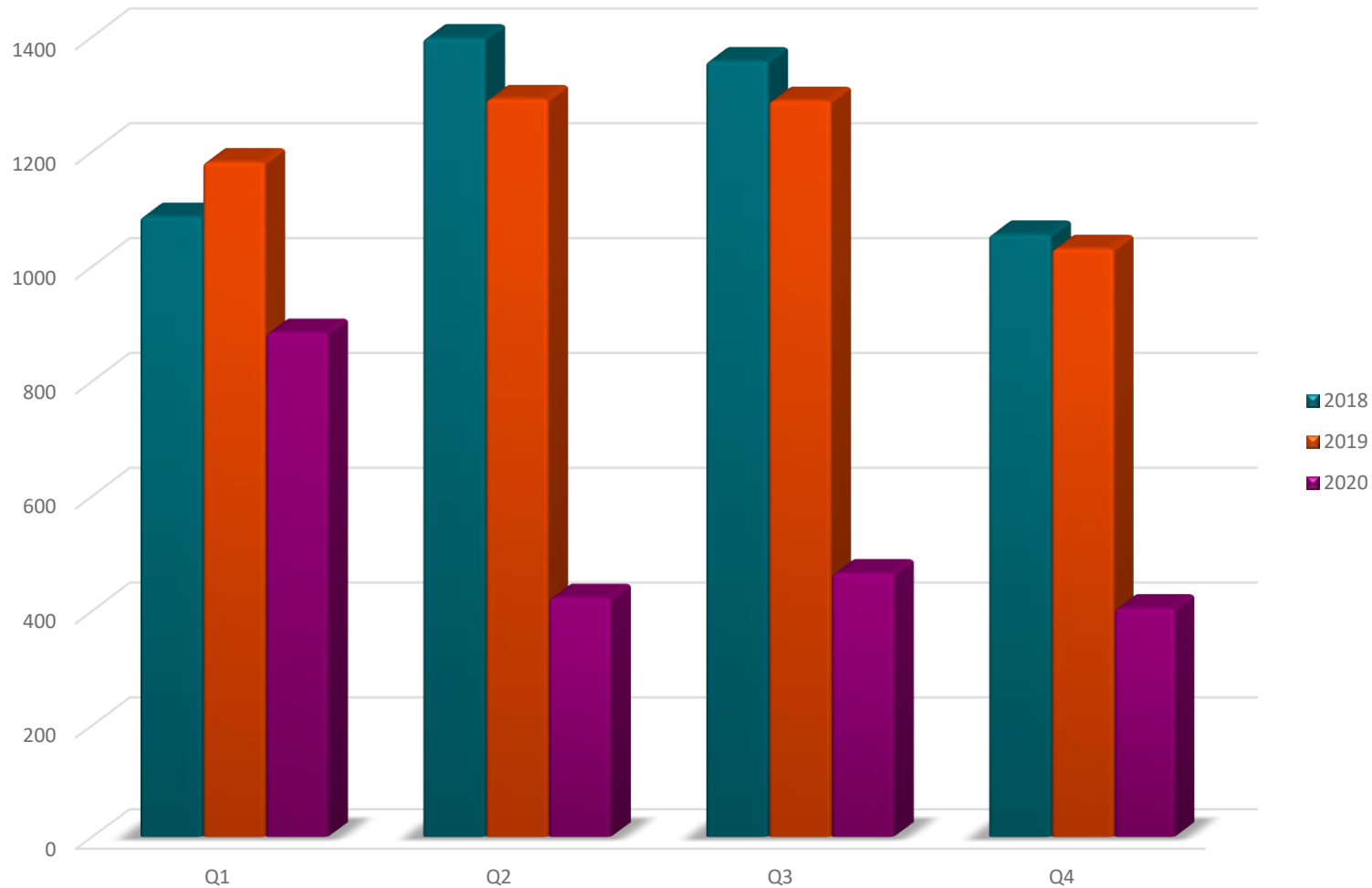

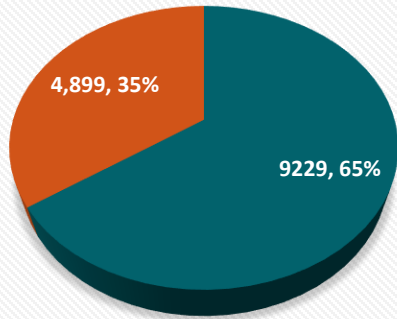

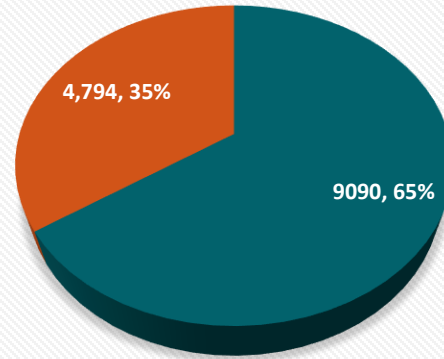

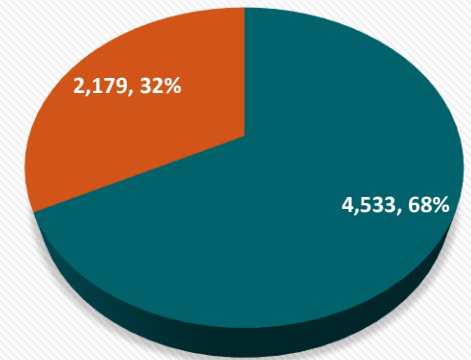

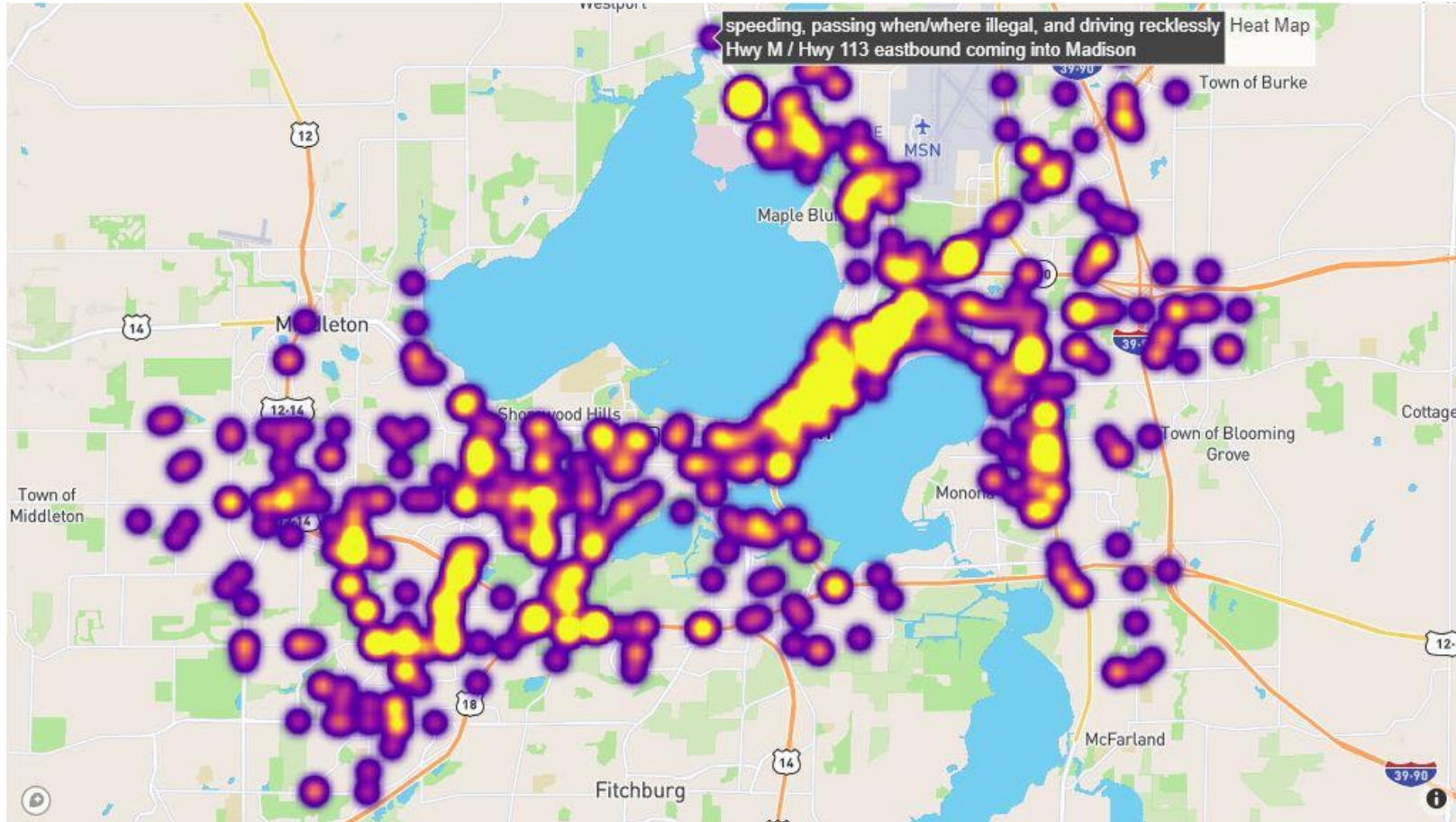

Traffic Complaints – 2020 City-wide



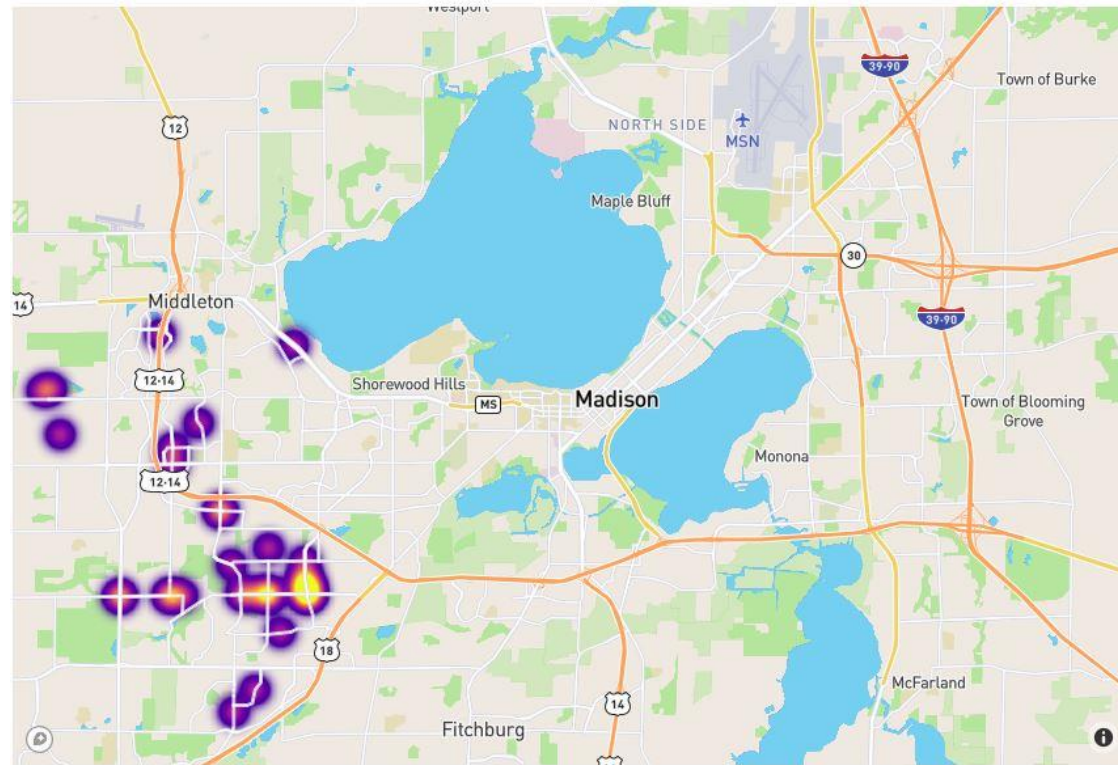


Traffic Complaints – Q4 2020 by District
