

- **To build more than 2,510 libraries** around the world--more than Andrew Carnegie!

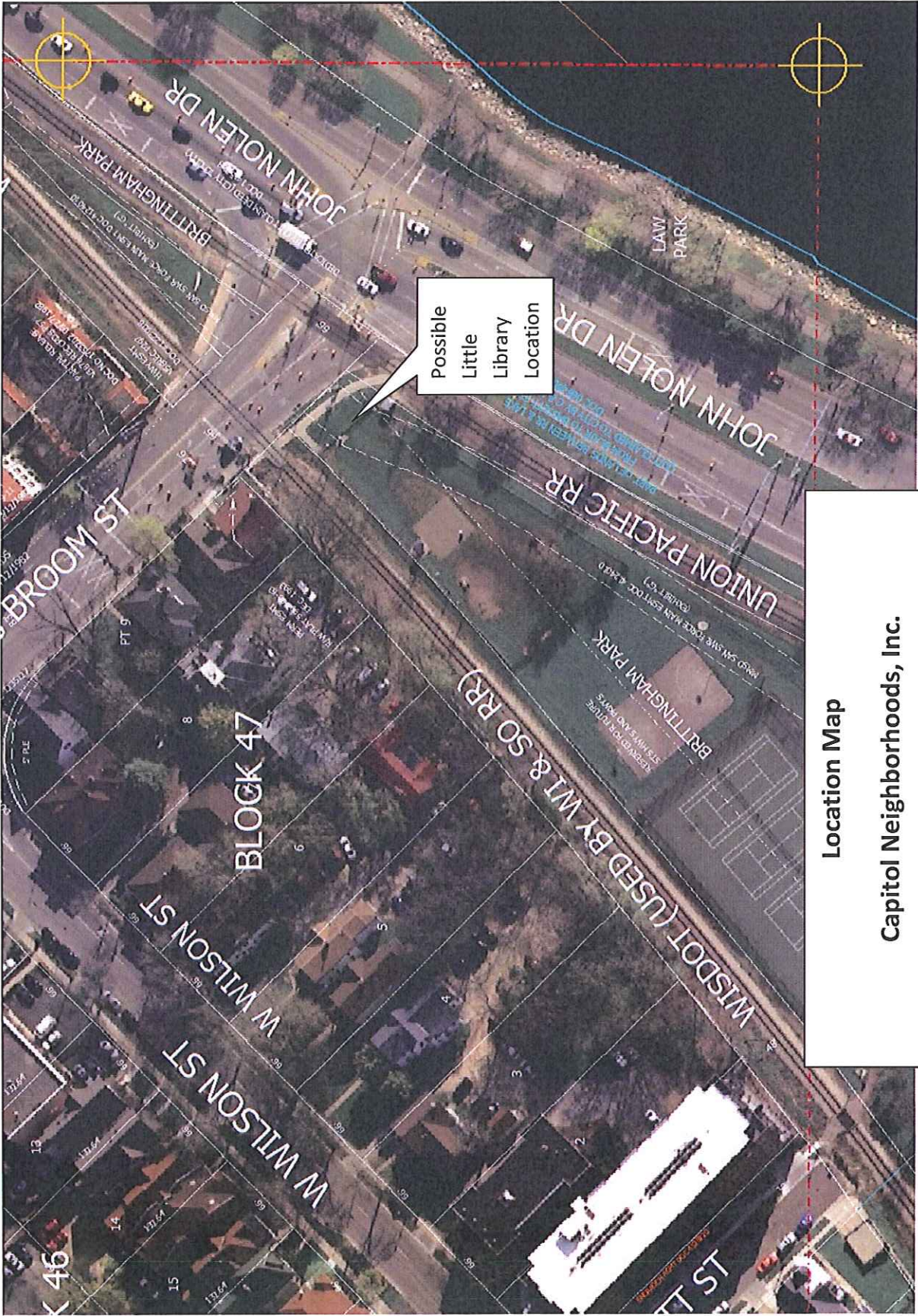
