DISPLAYS

In conjunction with the community Pie Toss area, groups participating will be offered an area for outreach, education and recruiting.

Clean up and removal of materials and miscellaneous items will begin at 11:00 PM and be completed in time for the street to re-open 12:00 a,m August 21st

Pending owner approval, larger items and rental materials will be stored in parking lot for later pick up and removal.

SAFETY/SECURITY

A first aid table will be located near the lounge/chill area in the adjacent parking lot (pending owner approval) WOOF'S will staff the event with our security team who will walk the street making sure everyone is abiding by wristband usage.

CLEAN UP/RECYCLING

12-16 Trash and recycling receptacles will be placed throughout street for disposal through-out event. WOOF"S staff will maintain and empty these into larger rented bin during event for final removal on Monday August 22nd

NOTIFICATIONS

Initial notifications have been made to businesses on the street asking them if they wished to participate as OUTDOOR Vendors. As of this time no one has expressed an interest in doing so. Subsequently WOOF'S will assume all responsibility for food, beverage and merchandise vending.
