Conceptual Approach

Project Description (400 words or less)

Project Description (400 words):

(sub)Community Resonance is a public sound art project exploring the resonant properties of the spaces we inhabit as a community. Reverberant spaces have been chosen around the city of Madison, mostly bike paths and pedestrian tunnels, and will be identified with a plaque containing a QR code. The code will link to a website containing a description of the project, text instructions anyone can use to perform a music piece in the space, and a musical score, playable by any instrument or ensemble, that emphasizes the most resonant notes in each space.

This project strives to build awareness of our soundscape and encourage listening, to our environment, to each other, and to our community. Participants can record their rendition of the score and upload it to an archive. At the end of the project, I will create a new musical work using these recordings, representing a public “sounding” of the streets and parks of Madison, WI.

The project will include a kick-off performance by myself and my own musical ensemble at the tunnel underneath East Washington Ave, along the Yahara River Bike Path. This tunnel has excellent acoustics and has space for both the performing ensemble and an audience across the river. I have received preliminary permission from Renee Callaway, Pedestrian Bicycle Administrator at City of Madison Traffic Engineering. She just mandated that we do the performance outside of commuting hours, and to include verbiage about safety and awareness within the project.

(sub)Community Resonance represents an opportunity for the City of Madison to support sound art, an underrepresented form of art-making, and spread awareness of different forms of artistic expression, while directly engaging people from the community and empowering them to create music together. I have chosen sites from a diverse geographical location within Madison, including the far westside, downtown, northside and eastside areas, meaning all residents of the city will have accessibility to the project. Ultimately, I aim to bring together a diverse cross section of Madison neighbors, both in the public performance that will kick off the project, and in the final piece composed from the community recordings.

Resonance Score

- I. Begin by listening closely to the sounds around you. What can you hear? What melodies and rhythms are present?
- II. When you feel ready, clap your hands loudly. Listen to the reverberations. How does the space (re)sound to you? What notes can you hear?
- III. Continue clapping and listening, eventually picking out one note from the reverberations. Try singing this note. How does it resonate the space?
- IV. Continue singing, listening to the resonances between notes. Sing the notes and closer and closer together, eventually leaving no space between them. While droning on this note, listen to how the space drones back, joining you in a performance.
- V. End when you feel ready.
