NOTES:
 1. All plantings shall conform to quality requirements as per ANSI Z60.1.
 2. All plant material shall be true to the species, variety and size specified, nursery grown in accordance with good horticultural practices, and under climatic conditions similar to those of the project site.
 3. Contact Landscape Architect, in writing, to request and plant material substitutions due to availability issues.
 4. All disturbed areas, unless otherwise noted, to be seeded with Madison Parks Mix by Olds Seed Company or equivalent, per manufacturer's specified application rates. All seeded areas are to be watered daily to maintain adequate soil moisture for proper germination. After vigorous growth is established, apply 1/2" water twice weekly until final acceptance.
 5. All plants shall be guaranteed to be in healthy and flourishing condition during the growing season following installation. All plants shall be guaranteed for one year from the time of installation.
 6. Existing trees to be retained shall be protected in accordance with Section 025211 of the Standard Specifications for Highway Construction. Provide a minimum of 12" of topsoil in all planting areas and 6" of topsoil in areas to be seeded/soaked.
 7. Landscape beds to be mulched with undyed shredded hardwood bark mulch to 3" depth min. Edges with commercial grade aluminum landscape edging, Permaloc, Cleanline or equal, 4" depth x 3/8". Mill finish.
 8. Install 24" wide stone maintenance strip around perimeter of building where no landscape beds are shown. Mulch with 1.5" washed stone to 3" depth over weed barrier fabric. Edge with commercial grade aluminum landscape edging, Permaloc Cleanline or equal, 3/8" depth x 3/8". Mill finish.
