

REMOVING A PORTION OF BROOM STREET
FROM
THE RESIDENTIAL
DAYTIME PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM
AND
ESTABLISHING IT AS A COMBINATION TWO
HOUR AND 25 MINUTE
PARKING METER ZONE
MADISON, WISCONSIN

The Common Council of the City of Madison, Wisconsin, having heretofore referred to the Transit and Parking Commission, Legis. File # 05539, "amending Section 12.1385(54) and creating Section 12.1517(12) of the Madison General Ordinances to remove a portion of Broom Street (on the east side of Broom Street from Washington Avenue to Doty Street) from the Residential Daytime Parking Permit program and establish it as a Combination Two Hour and 25 Minute Parking Meter Zone" (on the east side of Broom Street from Millin Street to Washington Avenue), to accommodate the need for short-term parking in an area that is becoming a mixed-use commercial and residential area.

That on March 13, 2007, as part of its regular meeting starting at 5:00 PM, The Transit and Parking Commission will hold a public hearing in Room 260, Madison Municipal Building, 215 Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, and will consider comments on the proposed changes that may be filed in writing or in person, and will hear all persons desiring to be heard.
