Members present were: Stu Levitan, Chair; Erica Gehrig, Vice Chair; Christina Slattery, David McLean, Marsha Rummel, Jason Fowler and Michael Rosenblum.

SUMMARY:

Staff requested direction from the Landmarks Commission regarding which historic preservation priority should have a Certified Local Government (CLG) grant application prepared.

The staff report noted three options. In response to #3:

Levitan asked how many potentially eligible National Register properties there may be in the Downtown. Staff noted that more study is needed.

Gehrig requested a list of 10 – 12 that are register worthy that are not City landmarks.

In response to #2:

Slattery asked if a larger survey area would yield more results. Staff noted that more study is needed. Slattery explained that it would be a very useful preservation planning tool to have a City-wide architectural survey.

There was general discussion about the three items. Staff will operate a list of 10 – 12 potential landmarks for review.
