WHEREAS Charles ("Chuck") Boehnen is retiring on December 31, 2009 after 30 years of service to Dane County. Chuck began his career on February 4, 1980 as an aide at Badger Prairie Health Center. He transferred to Public Health on September 22, 1991 where he has been a public health aide.

Chuck has worked in the WIC, immunizations, and the oral health fluoride program. Chuck welcomed and registered many families at immunization clinics throughout Dane County and entered their immunizations given into the Wisconsin Immunization Registry. Chuck has been the driving force behind the fluoride supplement program which serves children ages 6 months through 14 years of age who drink well water that is low in fluoride or live in the village of Dane. Through his service approximately 2,500 Dane County children per year have participated in the fluoride supplement program.
