- Component units In the financial statements, we are required to bring in the LLCs that are interrelated with the CDA - Truax, Burr Oaks, Allied & Monona Shores. Those are audited by SVA, a separate auditing firm who specialize in those types of entities. Those reports are included in this report.
- Erdman said the important things to look at are cash positions.
 Income statement, operational. The notes will tell you debt that is coming due.

- Brasser noted the amount on page 28, \$1,000,004. Meinholz said the Monona Terrace bond was issued through CDA. Bonds refunded in January. Won't be there next year.
- Ellingson asked where the fund balance is located. Meinholz said on page 5 (net position). Equity. Assets exceed your liabilities.
- Erdman: Village on Park Owe City \$10.5M. If we can't sell The Village on Park for that amount, we'll owe the City.
