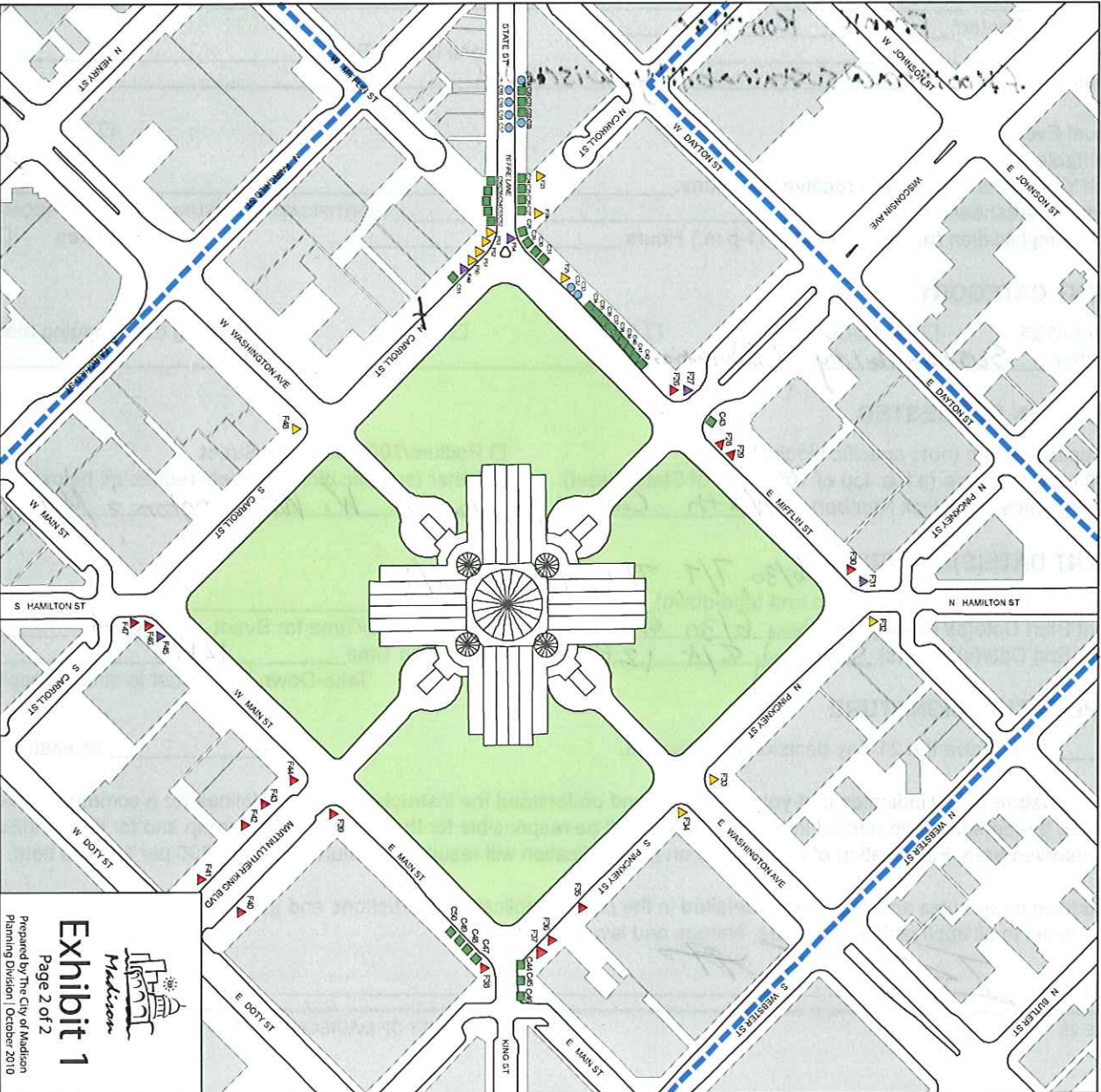
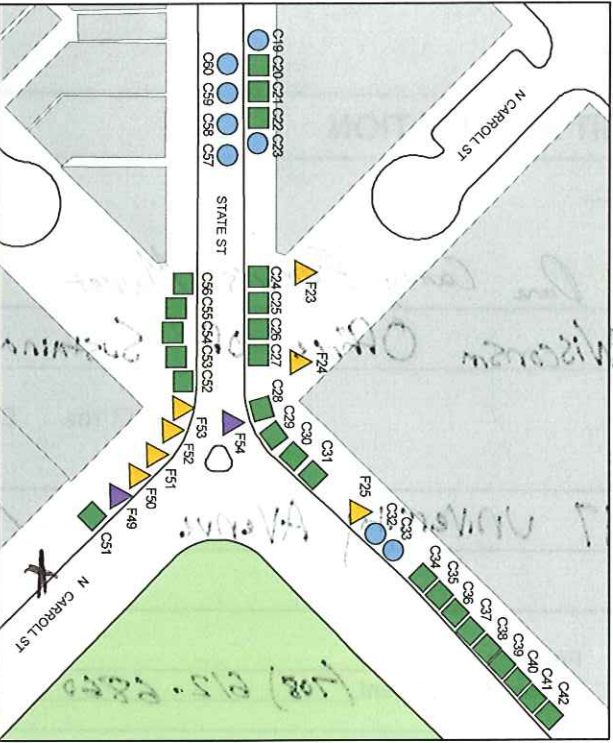

Permit Application Narrative

My name is Isaac Sinnott and I am an intern with the UW-Madison Office of Sustainability. I am requesting a street use permit for space across from the Dane County Farmer's Market on Saturday morning to implement a compost and recycling program.

The Dane County Farmer's Market is a centerpiece of the sustainability movement in Madison. I'd like to leverage DCFM patrons commitment to sustainability to encourage composting and recycling. We will provide educational information on composting while collecting food scraps. We will also collect items that are difficult to recycle such as batteries, media, eye glasses, cell phones, and printer cartridges. All materials that are collected will be processed at University facilities.

I am requesting a permit for a location on N. Carroll St. between West Washington and Mifflin. The proposed event will take place on Saturday mornings starting 6/30/12 and ending 8/4/12.
