1.	04433	Amending Section 3.38(1)(b) of the Madison General Ordinances by deleting the classification of Madison Arts Commission Administrator in Compensation Group 18, Range 10, and creating the class of Madison Arts Program Administrator in Compensation Group 18, Range 10 as a retitlement.
2.	04390	That the vacant position #632 of CitiArts Program Administrator, in Compensation Group 18, Range 10, in the permanent salary detail of the Planning and Development budget is deleted and created as the class of Madison Arts Program Administrator in Compensation Group 18, Range 10, as a retitlement.

Be it further resolved that the incumbent shall be reallocated to said position.

7.	<u>04572</u>	That the position #1475 of Clerk 2, in Compensation Group 20, Range 06 (occupied by W. Pfutzenreuter), in the permanent salary detail of the Parks Division budget is repealed and recreated as an Administrative Clerk 1 in Compensation Group 20, Range 09, thereof. Be it further resolved that the incumbent shall be reallocated to said position.
8.	<u>04602</u>	That the position #1462 of Administrative Clerk 2 in Compensation Group 20, Range 11 (occupied by P. Hario), in the permanent salary detail of the Parks Division budget is repealed and recreated as an Administrative Assistant in Compensation Group 20, Range 14, thereof. Be it further resolved that the incumbent shall be reallocated to said position.

13.	<u>04620</u>	Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin on behalf of the University of Wisconsin-Madison that would provide for dedication of two of Metro's five anticipated hybrid buses for use in UW campus service, in return for an upfront cash contribution by UW to reduce Metro's borrowing expense for the hybrid buses.

17.	<u>04567</u>	Approving the provision of \$50,000 in Federal HOME funds to assist Wisconsin Initiatives in Sustainable Housing acquire housing and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign an agreement to implement the project.
18.	<u>04573</u>	Authorizing the provision of CDBG funds to assist the Wisconsin Youth Company improve its neighborhood center facility in ways that address City, Community and Neighborhood Development Objectives.
19.	<u>04613</u>	Approving the provision of \$110,000 in Federal HOME/Match Funds and \$10,000 in Housing Trust Funds to assist Housing Initiatives acquire housing and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign an agreement to implement the project.
