

# **County Highway Reconstruction Projects in the City of Madison**

## **Reconstruction Costs are Shared**

- County Cost Sharing Policy results in the City paying about 60% of the local share and the County paying 40%.
- The County participates in most items at 50% however there are some items such as street lighting, aesthetic treatments to bridges/walls, and landscaping in which the County does not participate in.

## **Maintenance Costs are Shared**

- The County is responsible for the following items:
  - Snow Plowing
  - Crack filling
  - Pot hole patching
  - Lane markings
  - Speed limit signs
- The City is responsible for the following items:
  - Crosswalk marking
  - Street Sweeping
  - Sidewalk
  - Signage related to parking, cross walks, school zones
- The following items are a shared responsibility
  - Reconstruction
  - Resurfacing
  - Chip sealing
  - Traffic Signals

## **The Buckeye Rd (CTH AB) Agreement**

- All costs for reconstruction are per the County Cost Sharing Policy
- All costs for maintenance are per County policy except that the City shall plow the road starting the winter of 2021/2022
