## Authorization to Enter into an Agreement with the University of Wisconsin, Office of the Wisconsin Partnership Program To Apply Clinic Data to Improve Chronic Disease Prevention

Public Health—Madison and Dane County (PHMDC) has been awarded a development grant by the Wisconsin Partnership Program to partner with the UW Department of Family Medicine in a planning project. Through the project, staff will review data from a research database created from de-identified electronic health records. They will use the clinical data to establish baselines for chronic disease surveillance to inform public health planning and develop data-driven messages to engage diverse partners to improve chronic disease prevention initiatives in Madison and Dane County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County, on behalf of Public Health—Madison and Dane County is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Board of Regents, University of Wisconsin, School of Medicine and Public Health, Office of the Wisconsin Partnership Program, for up to \$50,000 for the application of clinic data to chronic disease prevention. The Director is authorized to sign the agreement.
