

Madison Gas and Electric (MGE) will be installing a new underground electrical line along Odana Road, Frederick Lane and Tokay Blvd. This new line will be installed on the north side of Odana Road (bike path to Frederick Lane), the west side of Frederick Lane and the north side of Tokay Blvd. (Frederick Lane to Caromar Drive). This work will begin in July 2012 and will be completed in late August 2012.

A public hearing for this project will be held before the City of Madison Board of Public Works at 5:30 p.m. on Wednesday, June 6, 2012, at the City-County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Room 108.

The new electrical lines will be installed by MGE and KS Energy Services in accordance with the city's standards and in compliance with a Permit to Excavate in Public Right-of-Way. This line will be installed using a directional drill to minimize disruption.

All terrace restoration will be done as required by the Permit to Excavate in Right-of-Way.
