





- 1. This Plat is subject to the following recorded instruments:

 C. Declaration of Protective Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions recorded as Doc. No. 5298483 and amended by Doc. Nos. 5302800, 5337700 and 5467972.
- D. Public Utility Easements granted by Doc. No. 5201276, partially released by Doc. Nos. 5712012, 5716861, 5716862 and 5716863.
- E. Public Sanitary Sewer and Water Easements, City of Madison TLE for Grading, No Vehicular Access Restriction and Building Setback Line Restriction granted by Doc. No. 5201276, partially released by Doc. No. 5712012.
- 2. All lots within this plat are subject to public easements for drainage purposes which shall be a minimum of 5 feet in width measured from the property line to the interior of each lot except that the easements shall be 12 feet in width on the perimeter of the plat. EXCEPT where shown otherwise on the face of the plat. For purposes of two (2) or more lots combined for a single development site, or where two (2) or more lots have a shared driveway agreement, the public easement for drainage purposes shall be a minimum of five (5) feet in width and shall be measured only from the exterior property lines of the combined lots that create a single development site, or have a shared driveway agreement, except that the easement shall be twelve (12) in width along the perimeter of the plat. Easements shall not be required on property lines shared with greenways or public streets. No buildings, driveways, or retaining walls shall be placed in any easement for drainage purposes. Fences may be placed in the easement only if they do not impede the anticipated flow of water.

The intra-block drainage easements shall be graded with the construction of each principle structure in accordance with the approved storm water drainage plan on file with the City Engineer and the Zoning Administrator, as amended in accordance with the Madison General Ordinances.

NOTE: In the event of a City of Madison Plan Commission and/or Common Council approved re-division of a previously subdivided property, the underlying public easements for drainage purposes are released and replaced by those required and created by the current approved

- 3. Subsoil information indicates that basements of structures within the plat may encounter bedrock. The sub-surface conditions report, dated March 8, 2001 and August 21, 2001, is on file with the City Engineer.
- 4. As the date of Plat recordation there is an active quarry operation on the lands located east of this Plat. Lots of this Plat may be subject to existing and future dust, noise and vibration generated by the adjacent quarry operations.
- 5. Lots within this subdivision are subject to impact fees that are due and payable at the time building permit(s) are issued.
- 6. No principal or accessory buildings or structures (pools, gazebos, etc.) shall be permitted within the building setbacks shown hereon. This restriction shall be enforceable by the City of Madison.
- 7. No driveway shall be constructed that interferes with the orderly operation of the pedestrian walkway. This will require all pedestrian ramps to be constructed separate from driveway entrances; a curb-head of no less than six (6) inches
- in width shall be constructed between all pedestrian ramps and driveway entrances.
- 8. Lots 1264-1275 shall have no vehicular access to Felland Road.
- 9. The City will not install lighting in the alleys, but the developer or property owners may request the City to approve a private light(s) in the alley right-of-way. Such private light(s) to be operated and maintained by the private interests.
- 10. The temporary easements for grading and sloping shall be released by the City of Madison by separate instrument upon the completion and acceptance of newly constructed street improvements within the Felland Road right of way adjacent to the easements.
- 11. The Landscaping Easement on Lots 1264-1275 is reserved for the planting and maintenance of trees and shrubs by the Village at Autumn Lake Homeowners Association. In lieu of the association, maintenance shall be the responsibility of the lot owner.
