Concerning plan for E Wilson St speed bumps. Please! No speed bumps on bike routes! There's already so many bumps, cracks, and gutter ditches to navigate, leading to an unpleasant ride. I bicycle that street 10 times per week, year round, and do not see speeding. If serious problem exists for residents at different hours, please find another solution.

I'd recommend closing car traffic on a portion of E Wilson, just east of Few Street, the same way the road is closed on the 1000 block of E Wilson, creating another dead end for cars but not for bikes. Close the roadway of E Wilson that is next to 301 S Few St. Have E Wilson St end at Few St when driving eastbound on E Wilson St. Keep the road open for the rest of the 1200 block of E Wilson so that corner property at 301 S Few can approach their driveway when coming from Baldwin St but not when coming from Few St.

That would solve any speeding traffic problem on E Wilson St. if one exists. It would also allow a safer approach to that entrance of McPike Park for pedestrians.
