We had one significant call for service at the 2601 Fish Hatchery on December 4, 2017. A side from that incident we have not had any other significant calls for service. I have had several communications with Mr. David Ring, Kwik Trip, Inc. - Community Relations Manager regarding their request to remove the one condition prohibiting the sale of single bottles/cans.

Captain Patterson and I have discussed their request to sale single bottles/cans and we have both expressed our concerns and our expectations if this should be approved by the ALRC to Mr. Ring. Mr. Ring completely understands our expectations, and he has agreed to meet with the South District Captain and myself in July/August to review any calls for service. The calls for service will determine the need to re-evaluate the sale of singles bottles/cans. In addition, South District Captain and I will continue to set up meeting throughout the year relating to any significant changes in calls of service at the three locations. Furthermore, the South District Captain and I will hold a neighborhood meeting regarding the specific convenient store location to discuss any concerns that may arise due to this change in the condition.

Therefore, I am willing to remove the one condition prohibiting this establishment from selling single bottle/cans. However, Captain Patterson and I are not supporting Kwik Trip to continue their daily operating hours of 5:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight. The change in the daily operating hours was discussed with Mr. Ring, and agreed by all was to change the daily operating hours to 5:00 a.m. – 11:00 p.m.

Therefore, I am requesting the following condition: Daily operating hours of 5:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.

In addition, I respectfully petition the Alcohol License Review Committee members support this condition for these locations.
