## **Summary**

Mike Cechvala, Madison Metro, provided more details on the charging station.

Kaliszewski asked if there were concerns with archaeology. Bailey said that staff is providing comments related to archaeology separately in order to keep the location of those resources private.

Kaliszewski said that she didn't think they needed to remain a consulting party for this project. She agreed there was little potential for impact to above-ground historic and architectural resources.
