<p>October 9, 2007</p> <p>>City Forester appears in front of BOE to answer questions regarding gypsy moth and it's impact on the public.</p>	<p>October 17, 2007</p> <p>>2nd West side meeting for gypsy moth. (Alder District 20)</p>
<p>November 6-7, 2007</p> <p>> Public hearing and city council amendments to Comptroller.</p>	<p>November 8, 2007</p> <p>> Forestry Meeting with DNR Gypsy Moth Coordinator Mark Guthmiller to discuss DNR's recommendations for spray blocks based upon egg mass surveys.</p>
<p>November 15, 2007</p> <p>>Adoption on Amendments.</p>	<p>November 12 –14, 2007</p> <p>> Work with Engineering Services to create proposed GIS shapefiles (map) for application to DANE County Parks (aka Dane County Gypsy Moth coordinator). Initial total acreage: 3,913.7.</p>
	<p>November 14, 2007</p> <p>>Submit gypsy moth application of proposed spray blocks to Dane County Gypsy Moth coordinator. DNR confirms estimated treatment costs are \$30-\$35 per acre. Thus, 3,913.7 acres would cost \$136,979.50 <u>not</u> including postage and printing of letters.</p>
	<p>November 19, 2007</p> <p>>UW arboretum notified City Forester that they may not treat their property for gypsy moth which may affect Madison property owners who have gypsy moth egg masses along Country Club Drive and Iroquois Dr.</p>

	<p>November 20-21, 2007</p> <p>>Work with Engineering Services to reduce spray block acreages recommended by DNR gypsy moth coordinator. Current proposed acreage: 1475.5 with cost of \$51, 677.50 <u>without</u> postage and printing.</p>
	<p>December 7, 2007</p> <p>>Dane County Gypsy Moth Coordinator submits proposed gypsy moth spray blocks within Dane County to DNR Gypsy Moth Coordinator.</p>
	<p>December 2007 - January, 2008</p> <p>>DNR Gypsy Moth Coordinator reviews applications and determines spray block eligibility. DNR accepts or makes requested changes to proposed gypsy moth block treatments and reports to each community that submitted application for aerial spray.</p>
	<p>January 2008</p> <p>>DNR posts <i>proposed</i> spray blocks on web site.</p>
	<p>January - February 2008</p> <p>>Dane County conducts public notification meetings for proposed spray blocks. Property owners have the right to object to being within a proposed spray block area, which then requires a minimum adjustment of 250 feet buffer around the objector.</p>
	<p>February 2008</p> <p>>Resolve landowner objections.</p>
	<p>February 2008</p> <p>>DNR provides exact cost of treatment per acre once spray bid has been accepted.</p>
	<p>March 2008</p> <p>>Dane County Gypsy Moth coordinator supplies final treatment block boundaries and acreage changes due to objectors.</p>
