Date and Time:

- Weekend day (or two days) to be determined sometime when there will likely be snow (January/February?)
- Full schedule to be determined

Location: First Street Triangle

- Bounded by Eastwood, Winnebago and First Streets. The area is considered right-of-way, and not a park, but has some amenities (art, sidewalks etc) that make it act like a small park for the neighborhood. No street closures would be necessary.



Food:

- Working with nearby businesses for ice cream and hot fudge, hot chocolate and coffee and other snacks

Activities:

- Neighbors carving a “café” out of snow
- Snow sculpting
- Music (Vo5 members are neighbors to the park) may or may not be amplified, necessary permits would be applied for if amplified.

Clean-up:

- Snow sculptures may (hopefully will) persist past the event, but organizers will make sure that none are dangerously tall or cause any safety concerns.
- SASYNA and Marquette have a long history of neighborhood festivals and understanding the need for proper clean-up.
- No alcohol will be served at the event, so no security should be needed.
