Greetings ALRC members-

I will not be able to attend tonight's ALRC meeting due to other obligations. I respectfully ask for referral to your December meeting allow me to co-host a neighborhood meeting in conjunction with the SASY neighborhood council. I have heard from many neighbors who are very alarmed that the sale of the Stop N Go to Kwik Trip brings the cancellation of the post office contract for counter and PO box services in the store. Other neighbors have contacted me who are generally concerned about alcohol density in Schenks Corners.

I share the disappointment in the news that the postal contract will end and would like to be able to work on solutions before a decision is made about the license. I understand the store is very small and Kwik Trip has a product mix they would like to offer but many people would choose the existing mix and the community benefit the postal services provide. The solution may end up being a new location but since an alcohol license is a privilege, not a right, and questions have been raised by the applicants proposed actions, I appreciate your consideration to allow me to work with stakeholders.
