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**Governor Doyle Approves \$3.9 Million for 'Transportation to Jobs' Program**

MADISON – Governor Jim Doyle today approved \$3,918,474 in grants for projects that will help to connect low-income workers with jobs through enhanced local transit services such as additional bus routes and vanpool and shuttle services.

"Access to safe, reliable transportation is critical for the working families of Wisconsin," Governor Doyle said. "Transportation is a proven investment that not only benefits workers but also strengthens our economy. Thank you to all the local communities and organizations for their work to provide essential transportation services."

The Wisconsin Employment Transportation Assistance Program (WETAP) combines federal, state and local funds to assist transportation-provider groups in all parts of the state. Enhanced transit services made possible through WETAP include additional bus routes, vanpool and shuttle services, vehicle loan and vehicle repair programs, and the hiring of local mobility managers who coordinate transportation services for area workers and employers.

WETAP integrates local, state, and federal funding sources into a single, coordinated program and award process administered by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation in coordination with the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development. For this year, the federal and state investment totals about \$3.9 million, with the local funding share totaling over \$2.6 million.
