Fraternity Tables

- Fraternities and sororities are allowed to set up tables on the property of certain chapter houses on the blocked off portion of Langdon. For example, if fraternity TDU wanted to put a table in front of Sigma Chi, they would be able to do so. The tables must be no longer than 6 feet long and must be on the property from the sidewalk away from the street. Tables cannot block sidewalks. This is being done because a majority of fraternities are not located on the 200 block of Langdon Street.
- Fraternities can set up booths to inform other attendees of philanthropies they have or charities they represent. They can have a donations jar out if attendees would like to make a donation. Those chapters with tables CANNOT SELL ANYTHING WHATSOEVER. The Block Party will not be buying a sales permit so absolutely nothing can be sold. This includes giving out “gifts” to those who donate. If fraternities or sororities would like to give out gifts, they must be given out to anyone who expresses interest.
