SUMMARY:

The Commission discussed the historic value of the buildings proposed for demolition, and registered its regret at the loss of the vernacular context of Madison's built environment.

ACTION:

A motion was made by Gehrig and seconded by Andrzejewski to recommend to the Plan Commission that the Landmarks Commission finds that the buildings at 123 N Butler, 2271 E Washington, and 1208 Drake have historic value related to the vernacular context of Madison's built environment, but the buildings themselves are not historically, architecturally, or culturally significant, and that the building at 125 N Butler has no known historic value. The motion passed by a voice vote.
