Hello,

With regard to the proposed Lakeside Street entrance for the new 999 South Park development, this is a terrible idea.

The developer should move the entrance onto Park St. There is already a perfectly fine example in the Sophia, with its entrance on Park St.

There is also an equivalent terrible example in the entrance to the gas station at Olin and Park. Northbound drivers on Park St routinely turn right and cut across traffic heading towards Park on Olin, in order to enter the gas station, often blocking lanes while they wait for traffic to clear. I have had drivers pull up perpendicular to me and honk aggressively because they want to enter the gas station. And this happens despite the fact that there is already an entrance for the gas station on Park St!

The gas station entrance on Olin is a terrible design, as would be the proposed design for a Lakeside St. entrance to 999 S. Park. Please do not repeat the mistake.

Put the entrance for the new development on Park St.
