Establishing a fee structure for the TDM Program

WHEREAS, a Transportation Demand Management Program (TDM) Ordinance was adopted by Common Council on December 15, 2022 (legistar 74423) as Madison General Ordinance (MGO) 16.03 with Transportation Commission responsibilities listed in MGO 33.56(6); and

WHEREAS, MGO 16.03 (5)(b) and (10), provide that the application and renewal fees be established by the Transportation Commission; and

WHEREAS, the program will go into effect on June 16th, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the fees should reflect the cost to administer the program, acknowledging that TDM developments with greater point values require more staff time; and

WHEREAS, a fee structure was created with the intent for the program to be self-funded over 5 years; and

WHEREAS, the fees can be reviewed and adjusted if needed to maintain program viability;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the following fee structure is created for the initial application and biannual recertification for all TDM plans.

Initial Application TDM Program Fee

A Base Application Fee of \$100 plus a \$15 Fee for each mitigation point required

Bi-Annual TDM Compliance and Recertification Plan Fee

No Base Application Fee, and a \$10 Fee for each mitigation point required.
