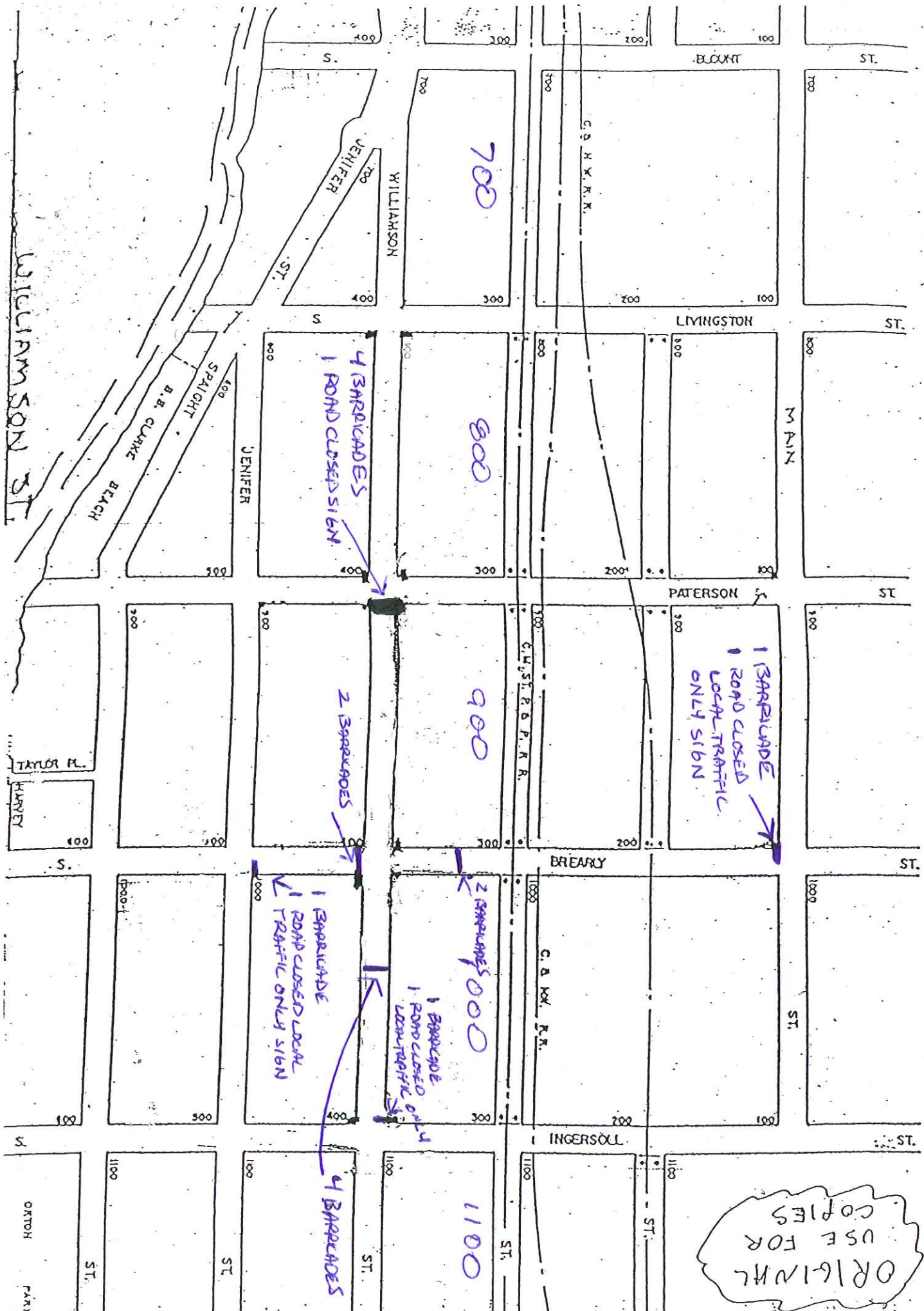

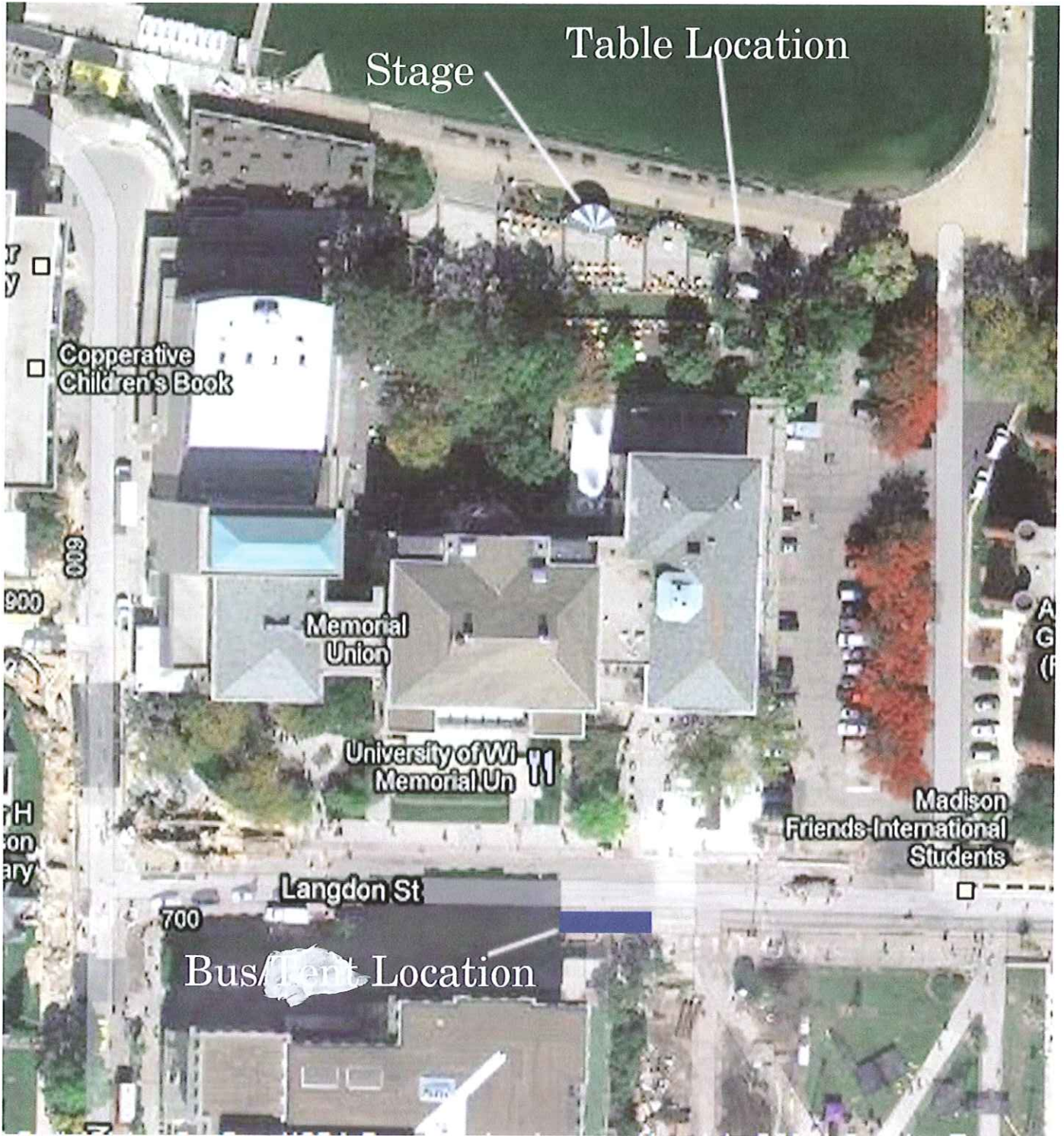

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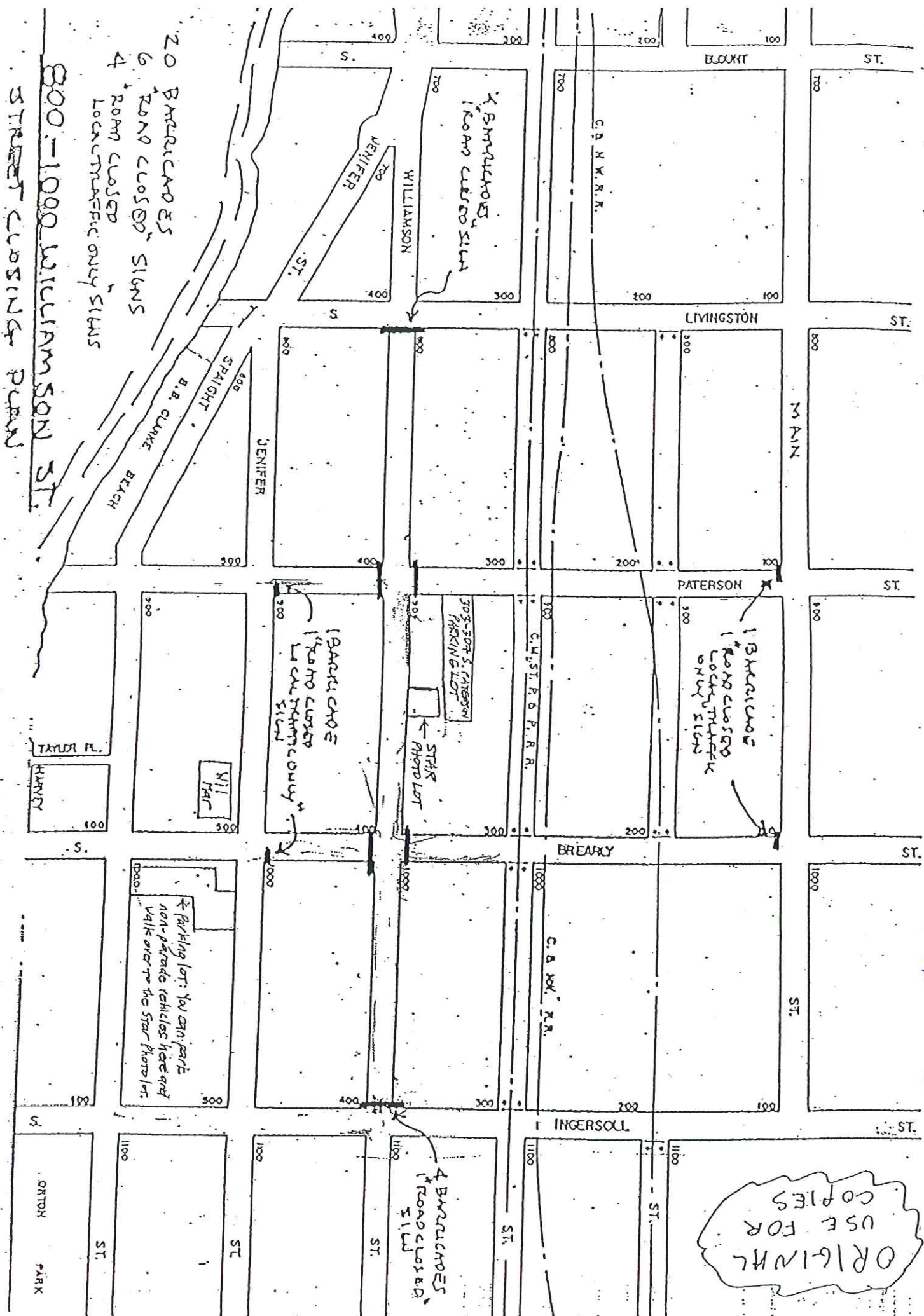

**SAFETY AND SECURITY PLAN**

After 30 plus years amounting to very few incidents, we plan to maintain a safe, secure and fun environment through comparable strategies including: employing off-duty police officers, private security guards, first aid on all three blocks and large information/first aid booths on all three blocks. In addition, a minimum of 12 (4 per block) experienced volunteers are in consistent communication with each other through walkie-talkies and cell phones.
