As required by the Base Closure Community Redevelopment and Homeless Assistance Act of 1994, as amended (the Redevelopment Act) and its implementing regulations, the Madison Wisconsin Local Redevelopment Authority (the LRA) for the Truman Olson United States Army Reserve Center is seeking notices of Interest (NOIs) for surplus property at the installation.

6) An assessment of the time required to commence carrying out the program.
