To the members of the P.T.C. ..

I am writing on behalf of my fellow metro drivers and myself as we feel our protection procedures are moving slowly while violence escalates on the buses and at the transfer points.

We feel that you are not getting a chance to see for yourselves that nothing has changed for the better since your June and July meetings in which we brought our plight to your attention. As we read the P.T.C. minutes and agendas, watch the online broadcast, or the cable channel 12 broadcast; we have seen no additional discussion and no firm plans. It seems to us that some P.T.C. members understand the problems with safety and comfort of the passengers and drivers while other P.T.C. members appear to be avoiding the decision and hoping the problem goes away. In the meantime; Metro drivers continue to be threatened, passengers are scared, personal attacks on drivers and buses continue, and the drivers and passengers are getting tired of the foul language and the fights on and off the buses.

On Wednesday, October 19th, my coworker Angel C. called in a report on a man wielding a baseball bat at the West Transfer Point. He was looking inside all of the windows of the parked buses looking upset and apparently looking for someone. Angel called dispatch and two squads responded but by the time they arrived the man had already left. Cameras could have caught this person on film and allowed the police another tool that they could have used.

On Tuesday, October 18th, I picked up a regular bus passenger, who is an older female; at Hamilton and Johnson Streets and I arrived at the East Transfer Point around 8:20 p.m.. I usually pick up the trash left on my bus by the previous run that I believe at 7:30 p.m. and I run across the street to use the restroom. This female passenger always stays on my bus while I am gone and when I leave she goes to a shelter to wait for her connection. When I pulled out on this night I noticed a car pull up in the adjacent lot by the semi-trailers from which a male got out and walked into the shelter where the passenger was sitting and he began talking to her. I slowed my bus down to keep an eye on her until I saw the Route 17 bus pull in so she wouldn't be alone. On Wednesday, October 19th, I saw the female passenger at the East Transfer Point and I asked her about the previous night. The passenger said he was asking her for eight dollars for bus fare and she felt threatened. Now I am going to wait for the Route 17 bus to arrive before I leave her alone and have asked the Route 17 driver to let her sit on his bus so she feels safe.

The 4 p.m. West Transfer Point to South Transfer Point Route 18/Allied Drive bus has gotten so violent that the two drivers who drive it and the passengers are scared. The Thursday/Friday driver who is male has been spit on and the Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday driver has had her life threatened.

How much more do we have to endure before something is done?

Someone is going to get seriously hurt or killed.

We have had more bus shootings, guns brought aboard the buses, fights on the buses and at the transfer points, and more vulgar language and aggressive behavior. I have only seen the police watching the South Transfer Point 3 times (while I have been there) since August of this year.

Just recently the news reported that Madison police have responded to more calls of shots fired this year than ever before. A 55% increase! This is a sign of the type of crime that is increasing in Madison with an increase in youth oriented crimes and gang activity. These are the same youths who are loitering at the transfer points, causing the fights, and continuing to be aggressive and threatening to the drivers and passengers.

At the same time rising gas prices could be an opportunity to encourage new ridership and promote the advantages of taking the bus, we are allowing an environment to fester and grow that is actually causing people to chose not to take the bus or at the very least to change their riding habits so they do not have to travel through any of the so called trouble routes.

For you to get a feel for what is going on, I had a union steward ask for incident reports from supervisor Randy Boyd. I then sat with the steward for a 1/2 hour and we picked some of the reports out. Believe me when I say there are a lot more reports that we did not include to keep from overloading you with so much information that you chose not to read any of them. I have enclosed copies for you to read and hopefully start the process moving again before or problems get worse or something really bad happens.

Please read these reports and let's get the cameras the drivers have asked for and put the new policy into action now. We need written flyers on the buses letting passengers know of the new rules and the consequences of their actions.

We would also like to be kept "in the loop" either through our union stewards, Georgian Springer, or myself; so we can let other drivers know that a safer workplace is just around the corner before someone gets hurt.

If any of you would like to go for a ride please feel free to contact me at 249-3398. I would be happy to show you the bus ride of your life and not on one of the nice commuter routes but on one of the mainline routes to see for yourselves.

Are you up for it? We have been doing it every day for years.

Please do something now.

Assault reported at bus transfer point

A 16-year-old Madison girl has reported she was sexually assaulted while waiting for a Metro Transit bus on Sept. 21, Madison police said Wednesday.

The victim said she was at the East Transfer Point on Milwaukee Street at about 7 p.m. when a stranger fired her into a secluded area and assaulted her before he fled on foot to a nearby park, according to police.

The suspect is described as a white male in his late teens or early 20s, approximately 5 feet 8 inches tall, with short brown hair, small sideburns and stubby facial hair. He was reportedly wearing baggy blue jeans, a floppy black baseball cap and possibly a white T-shirt, police said.

DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT: I picked up two African-American youths at the bust stop at inbound Odana Rd & Gammon Rd. They went to the back of the bus and immediately started swearing and being very loud and obnoxious. I pressed the canned message on the radio that asks that they refrain from using vulgar language. They thought that was pretty funny and continued to swear. After about two minutes, I pressed the button again, but they did not stop swearing. When we got to the West Transfer Point, I did not open the rear door because I wanted to get a good look at their faces. I did open the front door and several people exited the bus. They both started swearing at me and one began threatening me. The larger of the two was saying he was going to "beat my punk ass", and other threats like that. I was sitting in the seat telling them that the rear door was broken and they would have to exit through the front door. They did not know if the rear door worked or not. The taller of the two youths started to come at me in a threatening manner. As I tried to get out of the driver's seat, he pushed me back onto the seat. I then pushed him back with both hands, while I was still in a seated position. He started to fall backwards towards the door. As he was falling, he grabbed both my arms and in the process of falling backwards, his hands slid down my arms and he did break my watch. He did hit the front door frame with his back and possibly the back of his head. I told him I was calling the police and they left the area. While I had 911 on the phone I followed them, from a distance, into the Copps parking lot where I lost sight of them. The police showed up and took my statement. I then went back to my bus and resumed my route, leaving only two minutes late.





Specifically the young man carried that cane in such a manner as if it gave him a feeling of status or superiority.

Initially upon entering the bus, the young man was none threatening. Like a number of youths, he paid his fare (i.e., youth equivalent) and took a seat at the rear cabin. However, in contrast after departing the mall, the young man began to actively employ his walking stick in an aggressive manner. At Forest Run to Independence Lane I observed the young man strike the floor, the seat backs, and the walls of the bus with the cane via isle view mirror; moreover, the sounds filled the interior cabin with each blow. In response, utilizing the P.A. system I engaged the young man to cease this destructive behavior. It was then that the young man raised the cane to his eye level as to take aim at me through the isle mirror and simulate firing a projectile as if utilizing a rifle. Consequently, I immediately initiated a priority radio response (PRTT) via radio.

Observing my actions through the isle mirror, the young man abandoned his seat and walked to the front of the bus with stick in hand and confronted me; he asked, "Are you calling the police?" In response I replied, "No, I'm contacting my supervisor." In short, by the time base #1 returned my call the young man had fled the bus at the stop adjacent to Wendy's on Washington Street. In any case, I briefed base #1/Phil of the incident; as a result, he directed me to accomplish this report.
