

PSRC Meeting, 02/09/2022

Items of Significance since last meeting:

- No homicides in the month of January; 10 in 2021
- 4 fatality crashes in the month of January (4 victims)
 - Traffic Specialists assigned to the fatality crashes

Personnel:

- 2 resignations in the month of January
- No promotions, no lateral movements

SOP Updates posted to MPD's website since last PSRC meeting:

- None

High School Calls for Service in January:

- West-4, Memorial-4, La Follette-11, East-15

Shots Fired Incidents:

- 23 total incidents in January 2022
 - 6 subjects struck by gunfire fired by others, 5 occupied dwellings struck by gunfire
 - YTD 2021-2022, 7.6% decrease (26 shots fired calls in January 2021)
- 84 casings recovered in January
- The Chief's Quarterly Report posted on 01/18/2022 (Q4 2021)
 - 60 shots fired in Q4; 28 from 4p-midnight, 20 from midnight-8a and 12 from 8a-4p
 - 9 subjects struck by gunfire, 20 property damage

Strategic Plan Update:

- MPD's steering committee met with Matrix Consulting Group (MCG) on 01/11/2022 and 01/31/2022

- * MPD provided MCG with 21 requested data items under 5 general topics of: General Information, Personnel Data, Patrol Workloads, Programs and Other Department Data (case assignments, complaints, population)
- * MCG proposed two draft surveys; one internal and one external
- * Steering committee met to discuss proposed changes to the surveys
- * 3,000 surveys will be distributed, anticipated 400 returned (alert postcards sent in advance)
- * Timeline: Community Focus Group Meetings to start in February/March, survey results returned and aggregated April
- * Internal and external surveys reviewed by the steering committee for be submitted to the Chief's office for review (02/08/2022)
