At its November 7 meeting, the Plan Commission, meeting in regular session, found the standards met and approved your conditional use for a nightclub and outdoor eating area at **418 East Wilson** Street in a UMX district. In order to receive final approval of the conditional use and for any other permits that may need to be issued for your project, the following conditions shall be met:

1. Exterior doors shall remain closed and not be propped open during karaoke or other live musical performances.

Please contact Jacob Moskowitz, Assistant Zoning Administrator at (608) 266-4560 if you have any questions regarding the following two (2) items:

2. Hours of operation for the outdoor eating area shall end at 9:00 p.m. unless extended as part of a future conditional use approval.
3. No amplified sound is permitted in the outdoor eating area unless allowed as part of a future conditional use approval.

Please contact Julius Smith of the City Engineering Division – Mapping Section at (608) 264-9276 if you have any questions regarding the following two (2) items:

4. The Site Plan Possibly indicates encroaching into a right of way. The Applicant shall confirm and note on the plans all encroachments, including, (but not limited to) balconies, roof overhangs and underground vaults. Make an application with City of Madison Real Estate for a privilege in streets agreement. Link as follows - <http://www.cityofmadison.com/developmentcenter/landdevelopment/streetencroachment.cfm>. An approval of the development does not constitute or guarantee approval of any encroachments within a public right of way.

5. Provide legible plan to review. Plan scoop and items could on fully be determined from site plan provided.

6. Items in the Right-of-Way are not approvable though site plan approval, work with City Real Estate to start the 'Privilege in Streets' process to obtain an Encroachment Agreement for items in the Right-of-Way (bicycle racks, planters, outdoor eating areas.)
7. Items in the Right-of-Way are not approvable through the site plan approval process. Make a note on all pages showing improvements in the ROW that states: The Right-of-Way is the sole jurisdiction of the City of Madison and is subject to change at anytime per the recommendation/plan of Traffic Engineering and City Engineering Divisions.

8. Address items from the MFD Official Notice dated 9-19-2022 prior to MFD sign-off of this application.

Please now follow the procedures listed below for obtaining your conditional use:


1. After the plans have been revised per the above conditions, please **one (1) complete digital plan set in PDF format** of complete, fully dimensioned, and to-scale plans; the appropriate site plan review application and [site plan review fee pursuant to Section 28.206](#) of the Zoning Code; and any other documentation requested herein to the Zoning Administrator at SPRapplications@cityofmadison.com. (Note that that an individual email cannot exceed 20MB and it is the responsibility of the applicant to present files in a manner that can be accepted. Please email zoning@cityofmadison.com regarding questions or if you need alternative filing options) The sets of final revised plans or documents will be circulated by Zoning staff to the City department staff listed above for their final approval.
2. This letter shall be signed by the applicant to acknowledge the conditions of approval and returned to the Zoning Administrator when requesting conditional use approval.
3. The conditional use approval is valid for one (1) year from the date of the Plan Commission approval. During this time, the applicant must either lawfully commence the use or obtain a building permit and begin erecting the building. If the applicant obtains a valid building permit, construction must commence within six (6) months of the date of issuance. The building permit shall not be renewed unless construction has commenced as is being diligently prosecuted.
4. Any alteration in plans for a proposed alternative use shall require Plan Commission approval, except for minor alterations. The Zoning Administrator may issue permits for minor alterations or

additions which are approved by the Director of Planning and Community and Economic Development and are compatible with the concept approved by the City Plan Commission and the conditional use approval standards.

5. The Plan Commission retains continuing jurisdiction over all conditional uses for the purpose of resolving complaints against all previously approved conditional uses.
