This Plan will encompass approximately 20 acres of property owned by the State of Wisconsin. It will have residential, commercial and State office buildings on the site. This will be a multi-phased development.

The State is working with the Preservation of the Garden and Sheboygan Community Gardens to help relocate the community gardens that are on the site.

Linda Baxter Page, representing the Sheboygan Community Gardens, spoke about the meetings she has had with the State and the developers and is in support of the proposed plans. She is pleased with the cooperation the community gardens is getting from all involved.

Also in appearance to support the project was Jane Dennis, representing the Preservation of the Garden.
