The Madison Transit and Parking Commission will hold a public hearing on a proposal to modify parking rates at Parking Utility-operated lots, garages and on-street meters, and for residential parking permits. The hearing is scheduled for **Wednesday**, **March 9**, **2016**, **at 6:00 PM**, in Room 260 of the Madison Municipal Building, 215 Martin Luther King, Jr., Boulevard. (The public hearing is part of the Transit and Parking Commission's regularly scheduled meeting that starts at 5:00 PM.)

Staff is recommending the rate schedule proposal attached. The schedule is subject to change prior to the public hearing. If approved, rate changes are proposed to take effect June 2016. The last system-wide rate increase was made on June 1, 2012.

The proposed parking rate increases will serve several purposes, the most important being to develop sufficient cash reserves to replace parking garages. The Utility has three garages at or near replacement age. In addition to providing new facilities, the proposed rate increases are needed to replace on-street meters, and to repair and maintain current facilities.

The proposed rates for monthly parking continue the Utility's policy of charging lower rates for residents than non-residents. This discounted rate for residents is seen as a means to assess non-residents for a portion of the costs of the City's transportation infrastructure. Eligible carpoolers also qualify for the discounted resident rate.

Citizens are welcome to address the Transit and Parking Commission at the March 9, 2016 hearing, with each speaker allowed a maximum of five minutes to present comments. Notes

(a) Cashlered parking rates calculated in half-hour increments; 20-minute grace period

The Evening/Weekend Maximum rate applies to cashiered parking during the following time periods:

- Hours parked after 6 p.m. weeknights (until 5 a.m. the following day); and
- Hours parked on Saturdays/Sundays (from 5 a.m. until 5 a.m. the following day)

Parking garages can be used free of charge between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m. on days when a snow emergency has been declared.

Coupons: Businesses and individuals can request coupons for distribution to customers/clients.

We invoice for the value of redeemed coupons plus a 10% admin fee.

- (b) All garages and surface lots are enforced 24/7.
- Competitive Event Pricing -- UW/Kohl Center/Camp Randall Special Event pricing = \$5-\$15; Alliant Center Special Event pricing = \$7 (5800 stalls) (c)
- (d) On-street meters are enforced in general from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. UW meters in this area are enforced 8 a.m. to 9 p.m.
- (e) Eligible carpoolers and electric car drivers qualify for the (discounted) Monthly Resident rate and are entitled to immediate occupancy in select facilities.
- Parkers and the Utility are required to provide 30-days notice to terminate monthly parking agreements. **(f)**
- Regular Monthly Limited Hours, Monday Friday

Night Permit - (Created in 2014) Valid 7 days a week from 6 p.m. to 7 a.m. Rates are remaining the same.
