

**92386 Alder Mayer Amendment**

DRAFTER’S ANALYSIS: This ordinance adds an alder to the membership of the Police Civilian Oversight Board who would be appointed by the Common Council President for a one-year term.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

1. Subparagraph c. of Paragraph 1. entitled “Appointment” of Subdivision (b) entitled “Appointment and Residency of Members” of Subsection (3) entitled “Board Composition” of Section 5.20 entitled “Police Civilian Oversight Board” of the Madison General Ordinances is amended as follows:

“c. One (1) Member and one (1) alternate Member shall be appointed and confirmed by the Common Council. The regular member shall be an alder appointed by the Common Council for a term of one-year to expire on the third Tuesday in April.”

2. Paragraph 1. entitled “Terms” of Subdivision (c) entitled “Terms and Vacancies” of Subsection (3) entitled “Board Composition” of Section 5.20 entitled “Police Civilian Oversight Board” of the Madison General Ordinances is amended as follows:

“(c) Terms. Members Except for the term of the alder, members shall have staggered four-year terms, except that when the Board is initially created and filled, five (5) members shall be appointed for four-year terms, three (3) Members shall be appointed for three-year terms, and five (5) Members, including the two (2) alternate Members, shall be appointed for two-year terms.”
