#### **RECITALS**

This amendment is for additional work beyond the scope of the existing agreement and consists additional analysis for existing conditions and evaluation of design alternatives.

## Sub-Task 1 - Provide estimated 100-yr flood elevations for development proposals near Vernon Boulevard and Price Place

Provide detailed model results for purposes of facilitating development proposals in the referenced project vicinity.

## Sub-Task 2 - Street Centerline Inundation Assessments (zonal statistics) & Grid Cell Size Sensitivity Analyses

Support modeling and GIS activities regarding accuracy and precision of XP-SWMM modeling at different grid cell sizes and GIS display of model out using difference grid cell sizes. The intent of discussions is to determine the relative effect that model cell size vs. GIS cell size had on the ability to determine compliance with City flood reduction goals. Additionally, MSA will work closely with City GIS staff on GIS process techniques including python scripting, to develop processes for handling of data from watershed studies.

Provide the following informal deliverables to the City:

- XP-SWMM model variances, 10-40 foot grid cell sizes.
- Zonal Statistics Assessment
- XP-SWMM Outputs Grid Cell Sizes

#### **Sub-Task 3 - Inlet Capacity Analyses**

Analyze possible inlet restricted conditions at six (6) different locations within the Willow Creek watershed.

#### Sub-Task 4 - Proposed Alternative Scenarios – Additional Mapping Analyses

Iterate the proposed alternatives point of comparison from the 'University Avenue Improved' condition to the existing (current) conditions to understand the impact of the proposed solutions on the current conditions and the current University Avenue reconstruction project.
