

5 p.m. – Valet service arrives and places cones on N. Hamilton Street between lane of traffic and parking stalls on the museum side of the street. Valet station will be set up on the sidewalk outside the point entrance of Madison Children's Museum facing Capitol Square.

5:30 p.m. - Guests arrive

8/7 – Midnight – Event ends

8/7 - 1 a.m. - N. Pinckney Street reopens
